Beginner



Recommended Yarn

SIZE

Ca. 50 cm circumference, 32 cm height

MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Teddy, 100 g ball

Approx. 100 g ≈ 100 m

Col. 00035 (rose) 1 ball

The amount of yarn needed can vary from person to person.

1 circular needle size 8.0 mm (US size 11), 60 cm long

1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

GAUGE

Stockinette stitch: 13 st and 20 rows = 10 x 10 cm

THE BASICS

Stockinette stitch:

RS: knit; WS: purl.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 41 st and work in stockinette stitch in rows. When the piece measures approx. 50 cm from the cast-on edge (or when you are almost out of yarn), bind off all st. Do not cut the yarn.

FINISHING

Dampen and block the piece according the measurements; allow to dry.

Use the remaining yarn and a tapestry needle to sew the cast-on and bound-off edges together.

Weave in all ends.

p	= purl
R	= row(s)
Rd	= round(s)
RS	= right side
st(s)	= stitch(es)
WS	= wrong side
