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## SIZE

approx. 40" ( 102 cm ) long and $12^{1 ⁄ 212 "}(32 \mathrm{~cm})$ high (without ribbon).

## MATERIAL

Schachenmayr Denim Fantasy, 150 g ball
col 00050 (navy denim) ball 1

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## NEEDLES \& NOTIONS

1 circular knitting needle, size 9 mm (US 13) $32^{\prime \prime \prime}(80 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) long and 1 cable needle; $32^{\prime \prime}(80 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) of cotton ribbon in color of your choice, ${ }^{5 / 8^{\prime \prime}(1.5 \mathrm{~cm}) \text { wide. }}$

## GARTER STITCH

Knit (k) all rows.
Make 1 stitch: Pick up horizontal thread between sts and $k$ 1 through back loop.
Cable of 3 sts: Slip 1 st onto cable needle and hold in front of work, $k 2$, then $k$ the st from the cable needle.

## GAUGE

11 sts and 20 rows of garter stitch $=4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}(10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm})$.
Take time to check your gauge. If you have too many stitches and rows, switch to larger needles. If you have too few stitches and rows, switch to smaller needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The triangular scarf is begun at the upper center and worked in rows toward the outside.
Cast on 9 sts and $k$ the 1st row (= wrong side row).
Row 2 (= right side row): selvage st, 1 yarn-over (yo), k 1 , make 1 st, k 1, 1 yo, k 1 through back loop (tbl), k 1, k 1 tbl = 3 center sts, 1 yo, $k 1$, make 1 st, k 1,1 yo, selvage st $=15$ sts.
Row 3 and all following wrong side rows: Purl (p) the 3 center sts and $k$ all other sts and yo's.
Row 4: selvage st, 1 yo, k 1, make 1 st, k 4, 1 yo, work cable over the center 3 sts, 1 yo, k 4, make 1 st, k 1 , 1 yo, selvage st $=21 \mathrm{sts}$.

Row 6: selvage st, 1 yo, k 1, make 1 st, $k 7,1$ yo, $k$ the 3 center sts, 1 yo, k 7, make 1 st, k 1,1 yo, selvage st = 27 sts. Repeat rows $4-7$ continuously, increasing 6 sts in every 2nd row and increasing the number of $k$ sts on both sides of the center 3 sts by 3 sts.
When work measures a total of 51 rows $=12^{1 / 2 "}(32 \mathrm{~cm})$, measured at the center 3 sts, there are 159 sts on the needle. In the following right side row, bind off all sts.
Hide yarn ends on the inner side of the piece. Block the scarf, dampen, and let dry.
Sew a piece of cotton ribbon, approx. 16" (40 cm) long to each end, to tie the scarf closed.
