

# TheraMedic INSTRUCTION MANUAL

MASSAGE BED



When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following: Read all instructions before using (this appliance).

#### DANGER-To reduce the risk of electric shock:

- Always unplug this appliance from the electrical outlet immediately after using and before cleaning.
- Never use pins or other metallic fasteners with this appliance.
- Carefully examine the covering before each use. Discard the appliance if the covering shows any sign
  of deterioration, such as checking, blistering, or cracking.
- WARNING--To reduce the risks of burns, fire, electric shock or injury to persons:
- An appliance should never be left unattended when plugged in. Unplug from outlet when not in use, and before putting on or taking off parts.
- Close supervision is necessary when this appliance is used by, on, or near children, invalids, or disabled persons.
- Use this appliance only for its intended use as described in this manual. Do not use attachments not recommended by the manufacturer.
- Never operate this appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped or damaged, or dropped into water. Return the appliance to a service center for examination and repair.
- Do not carry this appliance by supply cord or use cord as a handle.
- Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- Never operate the appliance with the air openings blocked. Keep the air openings free of lint, hair, and the like.
- Never drop or insert any object into any opening.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
- To disconnect, turn all controls to the off position, then remove plug from outlet.
- Keep children away from extended foot support.
- Connect this appliance to a properly grounded outlet only. See Grounding Instructions.
- Use heated surfaces carefully. May cause serious burns. Do not use over insensitive skin areas or in the presence of poor circulation. The unattended use of heat by children or incapacitated persons may be dangerous.
- Do not operate under blanket or pillow. Excessive heating can occur and cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.


#### SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

#### **GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS**

This product must be grounded. If it should malfunction or break down, grounding provides a path of least resistance for the electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock.

This product is equipped with a cord withan equipment-grounding conductor and a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances. Danger-Improper connection of the equipment-grounding conductor can result in a risk of electric shock.

Check with a qualified electrician or serviceman if you are in doubt as to whether the product is properly grounded. Do not modify the plug provided with the product - if it will not fit the outlet, have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician.

During cleaning or when moving the chair, make sure to detach power cord from the wall and chair to avoid fire or electrical shock Do not place the machine on a unstable, uneven and unleveled surface to avoid damage, insulation failure or electrical shock



When storing the machine, make sure to disconnect power plug from the outlet and chair to avoid fire caused by electrical surges.



Clean power plug periodically to avoid buildup leading possible fire



Do not use it at any unsafe area or for any other purposes than personal use. Not for commercial use.



Do not store the chair in areas that are not climate controlled. Must be in room temperature with very low humidity.




Keep the power cord unobstructed at all time, i.e. not twisted, knotted, over bent or pulled and do not place anything heavy on it



Start running, automatically start five elements music and far infrared heating, can manually adjust the volume and turn off far infrared heating.

#### **Gradient pressure conditioning (approximately 25 min)**

Start running, automatically start five elements music and far infrared heating, can manually adjust the volume and turn off far infrared heating.

From neck, spine, leg to foot circulation sequence of pneumatic physiotherapy, each position four times, circulation total time of about 25 min; min; Suggest far infrared open.

## **Acoustic vibration conditioning (about 10min)**

Start running, automatically start five elements music and far infrared heating, can manually adjust the volume and turn off far infrared heating.

Horizontal position, lateral vibration, approximately 10 mino

#### **Gravity traction conditioning (about 10min)**

Start running, automatically start five elements music and far infrared heating, can manually adjust the volume and turn off far infrared heating.

The whole back of the machine is inclined to 10° (foot rising, head falling), 5 air bags in the spine circulation in turn pneumatic physiotherapy; conditioning time 10min; recommended to open far infrared hyperthermia.

#### Hi-speed sieve conditioning (approximately 10 min)

Start running, automatically start five elements music and far infrared heating, can manually adjust the volume and turn off far infrared heating.
