Put the appliance on a flat, stable surface with sufficient free space around it.



Do not use over water spills or very wet worktops.



Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.



Do not use this appliance on any other appliances.

Do not use the appliance on items that are not heat resistant, like plastic table cloths. Do not use it next to flammable objects like curtains.

#### POWER CORD MAINTENANCE



## 



Do not touch the power cord with wet hands to avoid electric shock or injury.



If the mains cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.



Do not let the power cord hang over the edge of the table or worktop or touch hot surfaces.



Always insert the power cord connector into the appliance before you put the plug in the wall socket.



If this appliance is to be used outside Hong Kong. Macau, or Singapore, use the correct and qualified plug adaptor. This appliance is suitable to be used 100-240V, 50/60Hz



The connector must be removed before the appliance is cleaned and the appliance inlet must be dried before the appliance is used again.



In case of any product malfunctions, unplug immediately.



Never immerse the appliance in water or any liquid. The bottom of the appliance and the socket area cannot be immersed in water. If water has gone inside the appliance, stop using immediately and wait for it to dry before plugging into the mains again.



Always unplug after use.

To avoid any danger of fire hazard, do not use any power cords that are not supplied along with the appliance or provided by the local service agent.



Always unplug after use.



Hold the plug connector firmly to remove the connector from the socket



Turn the operation to standby mode before removing the plug connector.



Do not use power cord extensions such as power strips.

# ✓! WARNING



Do not touch the body while the appliance is in operation.



Never attempt to repair or disassemble the appliance.



Do not immerse the main unit and power cord into water



In case of a fire, do not attempt to use water to extinguish the fire. Always stop the power supply first then use the qualified fire fighting substances to extinguish the fire.



## / WARNING



You are recommended to use distilled or purified water



Wipe dry before using the appliance.



In the following situations please ensure the appliance is unpluaged.

- No water in the kettle
- •When refilling with water

Do not drop the appliance or hit it with impact.



Do not use it for any purposes other than heating up water



Do not fill over the MAX line.



When the appliance is in operation, the body and mouth are very hot. Do not touch.



Do not twist the lid while the water is being heated up.



A minimum of 100ml of water must be used.



Pour the water out slowly to avoid injury.

Do not fill over the MAX line.



Do not store when the kettle is still wet.



Do not move the kettle when it is full of hot water.



When the body is still hot and requires refilling of water, beware of burns by hot water.



During and right after boiling, do not touch the venting holes of the lid.



Do not use this appliance to reheat soymilk, milk. porridge, coffee or oatmeal etc.



In continuous boiling, the inside of the lid could have some condensation water droplets or remains. This is normal and can be wiped out.


## USAGE ENVIORNMENT

- O Do not use the appliance on unstable surfaces. It is also not suitable to be used in very wet, very hot, or very cold environment
- O Do not use the appliance on items that are not heat resistant. like plastic table cloths.
- O Do not use it next to flammable objects like curtains.
- O Do not allow children to use it without supervision. It cannot be reached by children.
- O Do not use near IH induction heaters or magnets.



Keep the appliance and the power cord away from the pets such as dogs or cats as they could damage the power cord.

#### Read before use:

- You are recommended to use distilled or filtered water for best usage experience. This could avoid the limescale or minerals accumulating inside the bottle and the lid
- When the appliance is in operation, do not open the lid to avoid burn injury.
- Minimum 100ml of water should be filled to avoid boil-dry and product damage.
- The appliance has overheat protection. To use continuously, please wait until the appliance cools down before the next use.
- While the water is being heated up, stay away from the appliance and ensure the lid and its venting holes are not covered or blocked.

### Before first use:

Wash the inside of the bottle thoroughly and wipe dry the outside.

## Usage:


- 1.Turn the lid anti-clockwise to open.
- Fill in water and do not fill over the MAX line.

### •Connecting to power:

- Ensure the appliance is dry and there are no foreign objects between the connecting socket and power cord connector.
- Open the socket cover. Plug the power cord connector into the connecting socket. Plug in the other end to the mains.
- Once the power is connected, ensure the bottle is placed upright and all the parts are installed properly.
- 4.Before moving the bottle, make sure the power is disconnected. If the power cord is damaged, please contact the local service agent for service. The parts and your hands must be dry before touching the power cord and parts.







#### OPERATION MODES

### 1) Standby Mode

When the kettle is connected to power, it beeps once and indicator light blinks once to enter standby mode.

## 2) Heating Mode 1 (Boiling)

- 1.In standby mode, touch the indicator light once to get the Red light. After 3 seconds the Red light blinks and it will start heating up the water until it boils.
- 2.As soon as it boils, it beeps 3 times. Red light is turned off and the kettle returns to standby mode.

### 3) Heating Mode 2 (Keeping Warm)

- 1.In standby mode, touch the indicator light twice to see the Orange light. After 3 seconds the Orange light blinks and it will start heating up the water until it reaches 45°C.
- 2.As soon as it reaches 45°C, it beeps 3 times and stops continuous heating. Orange light remains on continuously. It keeps the water at 45°C for 8 hours.

#### 4) Cancel

While the kettle is in operation, touch the indicator light to turn off the light. It will stop heating up and return to standby mode.

## 5) Switching the heating mode

To switch the heating mode while in operation, cancel the original operation first to return to standby mode, then select the heating mode again.

## **CLEAN AND CARE**

### Maintenance of the kettle body

- Before cleaning, always unplug the power cord connector and cover the socket with the silicone cover.
- O Do not immerse in water.
- In case any water drips into the appliance, use a hair dryer to blow dry before use.
- Do not use detergent, thinner, gasoline, bleach, melamine cloth or hard brushes to clean.
- O Use a piece of dry cloth to wipe the kettle surface and bottom.
- Limescale could form on the inside of the kettle while heating up tap water. Clean after every use. You might need to use citric acid or vinegar to help wash away.
- Do not allow leftover water to remain idle in the kettle after use.
   Leaving it idle could result in bad smell and germs.
- After use, make sure the kettle is totally dry before putting in storage.



## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Before sending in the appliance for service, please check the points below:

Symptoms Areas to check When it is heating up, is the indicator light turned on? The indicator light might be broken.
