Safety precautions

- If the external cable or cord of the lamp is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or a similarly qualified person to avoid any potential hazards.
- Consult a professionally qualified electrician if in any doubt.
- Keep the product well out of reach of children.

Cleaning instructions

- Wipe surface of the shade with a dry cloth.
- Do not use any abrasive cleaning tools such as steel wool, scouring sponges or stiff brushes.
- Never use strong cleaning agents such as white spirit, turpentine, household glass cleaner or cellulose thinners.

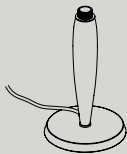

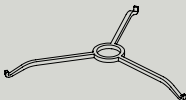

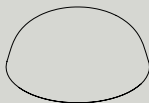

Tools needed

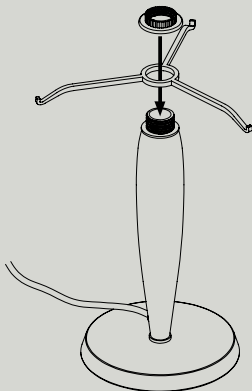
- Bulb type E14 (dimnable)

Step 1 / 3

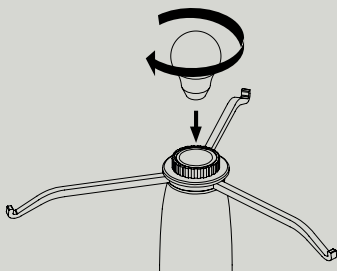
Place the shade bracket over the socket and screw the lamp holder ring back on the socket to secure it.

Step 2 / 3

Place the light bulb on the socket and ensure that it sits tight.

Carefully place the shade onto the shade bracket.
