
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



24" Cabinet Maker's Picture Light

Item # SL2706

WE RECOMMEND INSTALLATION OF THIS LIGHTING FIXTURE BE DONE BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN.

WARNING***SWITCH OFF THE MAIN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE MAIN FUSE BOX/CIRCUIT BREAKER BEFORE INSTALLATION.

INSPECT ITEM CAREFULLY BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO INSTALL. IF THERE IS ANY DAMAGE OR OBVIOUS DEFECT. DO NOT INSTALL

ITEM MAY NOT BE RETURNED ONCE IT HAS BEEN INSTALLED.

NOTE: CAREFULLY UNPACK EACH PIECE IN TOP LAYER OF PACKING PRIOR TO REMOVING. RETAIN ALL PACKING MATERIAL UNTIL INSPECTION AND **INSTALLATION ARE FINAL.**

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the box.
- 2. Remove the mounting plate (C) and (J) from the fixture body (D) by unscrewing the side
- 3. Put the mounting plate (C) on the wall, mark the anchor holes position with pencil (not included). Drill holes on the wall and insert the anchors (B) into the holes.
- 4. Install the mounting plate (C) to the wall and secure with the wood screws (H).
- 5. Install the mounting plate (J) to the junction box and secure with the mounting screws (G).
- 6. Wrap the fixture ground wire to the green ground screw on the mounting plate (J) and secure, then connect to ground wire in the junction box using wire nut (A). IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THIS FIXTURE BE GROUNDED.
- 7. Connect the fixture white wire to neutral wire in the junction box using the wire nut (A).
- 8. Connect the fixture black wire to hot wire in the junction box using the wire nut (A). DO NOT REVERSE THE HOT AND NEUTRAL CONNECTIONS OTHERWISE SAFETY WILL BE COMPROMISED.
- 9. Install the fixture body (D) to the mounting plate (C) and (D) and secure with the side screws (E).
- 10. Insert light bulbs (not included) into sockets.
- 11. To adjust the fixture shade loosen the adjustment knobs (F), adjust to desired position, then lock tight knobs (F).
- 12. Installation is complete, turn on power at fuse or circuit breaker.









^{***}Clean with a dry, soft cloth only. Use no harsh abrasives or chemical agents.
