How to put it together

You've got your raised garden or planter box built, so now it's time to fill it.



Line your garden or planter

Spread weed mat or alternatively about 6 layers of old newspaper over the ground to help prevent weed growth. Wet down with a little water to hold the paper in place.



Green layer

The first layer should be green material such as lawn clippings etc, and the soil you removed when you were preparing the garden. This will break down and provide great worm food, attracting worms to your garden and a creating nice rich soil.



Use quality soil

Cover your green layer with layers of potting mix and compost, or make it even easier by simply filling with the **Intelligro Veggie Garden Mix** for the perfect balance of nutrients.



What soil to use

Aim to fill your raised garden up to approximately 50mm from the top. Make sure it is level then you are ready to plant your vegetables or flowers.
