



START UP GUIDE

Congratulations on your new custom PC! Here are a few tips and pointers to get you all set up

Preparing your PC for first time use

- When you first receive your PC make sure there is no damage by checking all sides and the box it came in. If there is any damage or anything moving around in the PC, please contact us and keep your original box in case a return is needed.
- Next, remove the packing foam inside and stick on your warranty sticker, then power on your PC with just the power plugged in and make sure it turns on.
- Connect the PC to your monitor by plugging into your graphics card at the back of the machine. Don't plug into the onboard graphics. See guide overleaf
- If everything loads with no issues, continue to plug in your peripherals and Windows will automatically find any drivers needed.

Warning! All of our custom builds will contain packing foam in order to protect the parts inside: please ensure this is removed and the warranty sticker provided is placed in order to retain your warranty.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO HOLD ONTO YOUR ORIGINAL PACKAGING FOR AT LEAST 30 CALENDAR DAYS IN CASE THERE IS A NEED FOR A RETURN

PLUGGING INTO YOUR DISPLAY

If you have a custom PC with its own graphics card, you will need to plug your HDMI cable or your display cable into either the HDMI or display port DIRECTLY into your graphics card. This is usually located underneath the motherboard ports.
