# **August 30: Dealer Day**

Dealer Day is a special day for our bike dealers. At 5:00pm we will meet at Gella's Diner for a meet-n-greet and dinner. After dinner we will all meet at the RANS factory for a special presentation of the 2013 line-up of RANS bikes and talk about sales and build tips.

We will meet at the Midland Railroad Hotel parking lot at 8:00am in Wilson, KS. The ride goes to Wilson lake, crosses Hell Creek bridge, on to Dorrance, then returning back to the Midland at Wilson for lunch. There will be a bonus route that takes you over the Dam and to the lookout point on the west side. See the map for mileage and to decide if the bonus route is for you. The 28-mile loop to the lake through Dorrance has a fun set of hills for 7 miles. Both routes offer up some beautiful views of the lake.
