Exposed brick walls, salvaged fence boards, and simple Shaker cabinet fronts—some in natural white oak, others painted Benjamin Moore Harbor Gray—lend an industrial look and infuse the kitchen with patina. A copper finish on pendants above the island complements the mix of metals: polished-brass faucet, black hardware, and wire mesh on upper cabinets at the range.
