

Directions: In the story, Wow Vowels, you met A, E, I, O, U, and Y. Read the sentences from the story below and underline all the Wow Vowels that you see. Hint: Remember that Y is only a vowel some of the time. If you see a word that starts with Y, then Y is not a vowel in that word.

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When is Y a Vowel?



Y is sometimes a vowel. What does that mean? It depends on where it is in the word, and what sound it makes.

Not a Vowel: When Y is at the beginning of a word, it sounds like "yuh" and it is not a vowel, like this: yes or yam

<u>A Vowel</u>: When Y is in between two letters that are not vowels, or is at the end of a word, it <u>is</u> a vowel. Vowel Y borrows sounds from E and I. It can make words like this: <u>cry</u>, <u>icy</u>, or <u>gym</u>.

Long and Short

Y is not the only vowel that makes more than one sound. A, E, I, O, and U can too. The two different kinds of sounds that vowels can make are called long and short.

Short Long

A makes at and ate.

E makes ten and teen.

I makes <u>hid</u> and <u>hide</u>.

O makes hop and hope.


U makes <u>cut</u> and <u>cute</u>.
