



BINGO CARD DETAILS

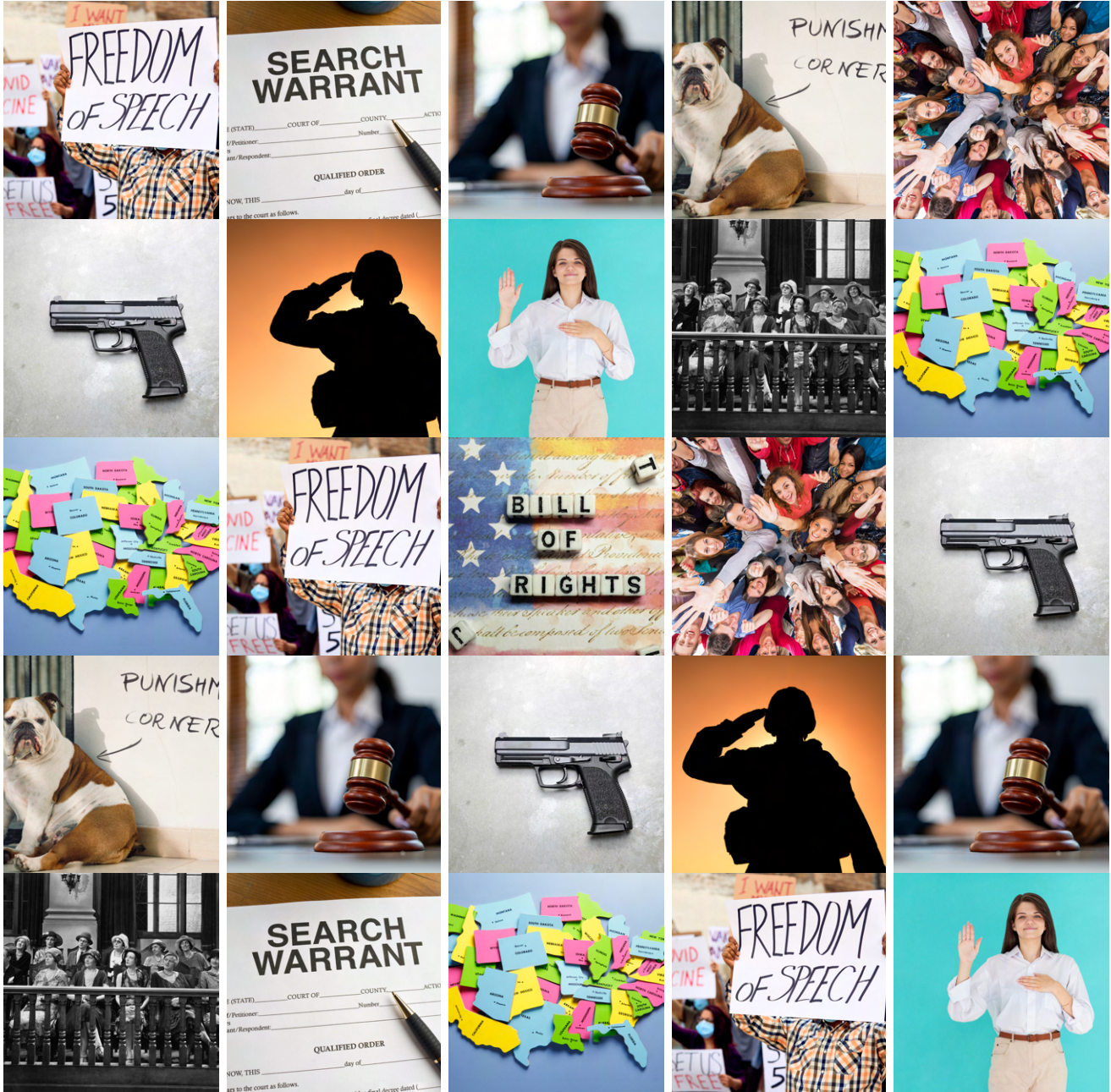
- There are 5 different Bingo cards to print. This will help the kids have different cards so they all don't win at the same time. I have 9 kids in my class, so 2 kids will have the same card. I will also use this at home for my kids.
- I used visual images to represent the Bill of Rights so that all ages could play and reading isn't required.
- The answer key will help you show the class what each card means before you begin and will serve as a reminder when you call the cards out.
- Print and cut out the 5 pictures of each Bill of Rights and place them in a bag to draw for Bingo.
- The Bill of Rights center space is a free space.
- I will place my Bingo cards in clear protectors and have the kids color the squares with an erasable marker as they play. Wipe and erase to play again!
