SHOWER TRAILER: Manage and clean the Food with Friends' shower trailers for users. Wednesdays from 10:00am – 2:00pm
TRANSPORTATION VOLUNTEER: Assist with transportation of participants to woodworking events, for special outings, to church services. Volunteer can be a driver or can ride along for the fun.
SPECIAL EVENTS VOLUNTEER: Help with our special events throughout the year; Auction, Christmas Concert, tabling at Bazaars and Community Events, etc.
