SPREADER PATCH - Fitting Instructions

Mainsail

Step 1: Hoist the Mainsail to appropriate luff tension

- Step 2: Mark where the spreaders contact the sail
- Step 3: Drop the sail and locate the marks
- Step 4: Clean sail with Methylated Spirits and a clean rag

Step 5: Apply the spreader patch and firmly rub all over using shiny side of the backing paper to create heat. If you are supplied with two different sizes of patches for each spreader, fit the smaller patch first and then fit the larger patch over the top to create a double layer

Headsail

Step 1: Hoist the Headsail to appropriate luff tension

Step 2: Mark where the spreaders contact the sail

- Step 3: Drop the sail and locate the marks
- Step 4: Clean sail with Methylated Spirits and a clean rag

Step 5: Position the patch over the mark and try keeping the patch parallel to the deck line. Then fold and trim the longest edge around the leech to ensure secure and neat fit

Step 6: Apply the spreader patch and firmly rub all over using the shiny side of the backing paper to create heat

Note: Never fit patches to wet or dirty sails.
