








Learn to play hopscotch



WHAT YOU NEED

- 1. Chalk or masking tape
- 2. A small "marker" to gently toss a bean bag, pebble, stick, shell, button, etc.

HOW TO PLAY

- Use chalk to draw a hopscotch pattern on the ground outside, or use masking tape to create the pattern on the floor inside.
- 2. Create your pattern like the example and number each section.
- 3. Toss your marker onto section #1.
- 4. Hop through all of the sections, turn around, and hop back to the starting point while skipping the square your marker is on.

- Hop on one foot for solo sections and land on two feet for sections that are side by side.
- 6. Pick-up the marker on your way back and pass it to the next person.
- 7. After each person takes a turn during round 1, start round 2 by tossing the marker onto section #2. Then start round 3 by tossing the marker onto section #3, and so on.


