Lucy Maud Montgomery was born at Clifton (now New London), Prince Edward Island, Canada, on November 30, 1874. She achieved international fame in her lifetime, putting Prince Edward Island and Canada on the world literary map. Best known for her Anne of Green Gables books, she was also a prolific writer of short stories and poetry. She wrote over 500 short stories and poems, and twenty novels, before her death in 1942.

Every month, for a whole year, you will receive one of Lucy's short stories in a letter posted to your home address. These stories have been carefully curated with the family reader in mind and are a wonderful way to spend time reading the letters together. There will also be keepsakes included with each letter.

Your first letter will arrive in approximately 21 days (though usually sooner), then monthly after that. We hope you enjoy receiving your letters and re-discover your love for Lucy's story telling style.
