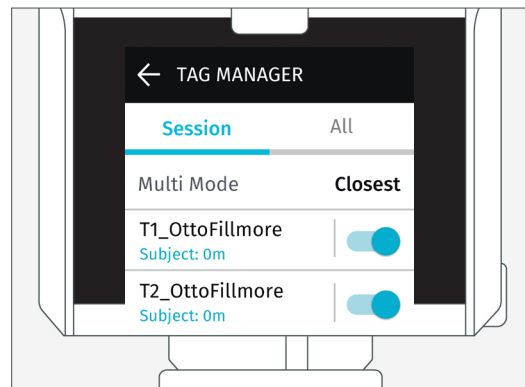
About Multi-Mode

Track multiple Tags using one or more Cameras. You can choose from four different options: fastest, closest, button press and group.

1. Select Tags

From the Track App, Tap the Tag icon ().

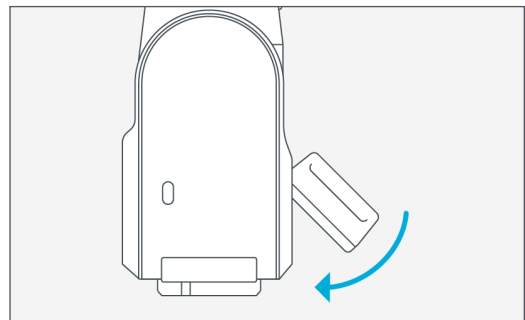
Select the Tags that you would like to Track.



TROUBLESHOOTING

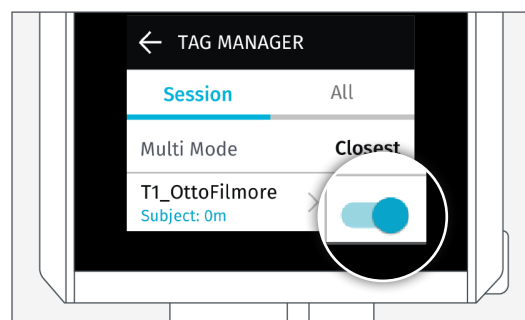
If the Tag is not shown in the Tag Manager

A. Dock the Tag(s) to the front of the Camera Base.



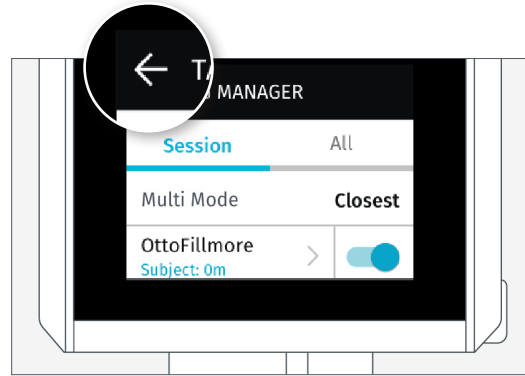
B. You will see your Tag appear in the list.

Ensure Tracking is toggled ON ().



C. Undock your Tag.

Tap the back arrow (←) in the top left to return to the main screen of the Track App.



2. Select Follow Mode

- Choose between three Multi Mode Settings that instructs how your Camera will switch between tracking Tags.
- Each Camera can have different Multi Mode Settings.

Closest

The Camera will track the closest Tag.

Fastest

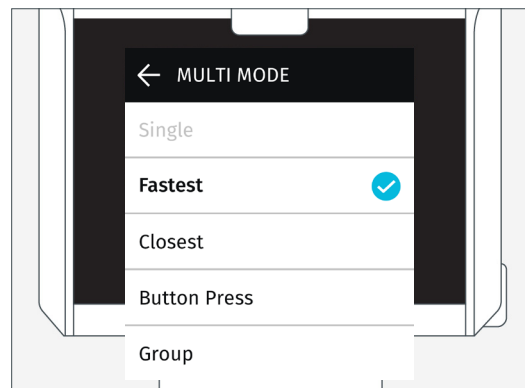
The Camera will track the fastest moving Tag.

Button Press

Tapping the (+) button on the Tag will trigger the Camera to begin tracking that specific Tag.

Group

The Camera will adjust zoom in an aim to keep everyone wearing a Tag in the frame.



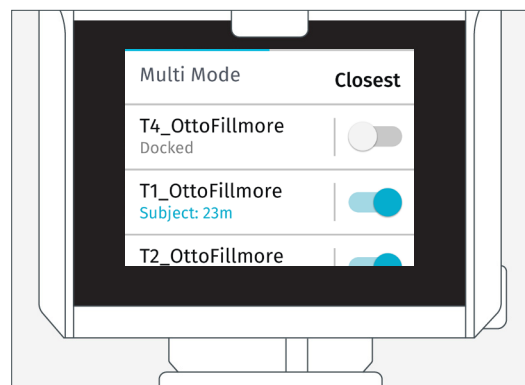
Scenario: Track Multiple Tags from a Single Camera

Requirements

- The Tags that you'd like to track in the session must already be saved to the Camera.
- If the Tags are not saved, see TROUBLESHOOTING above.

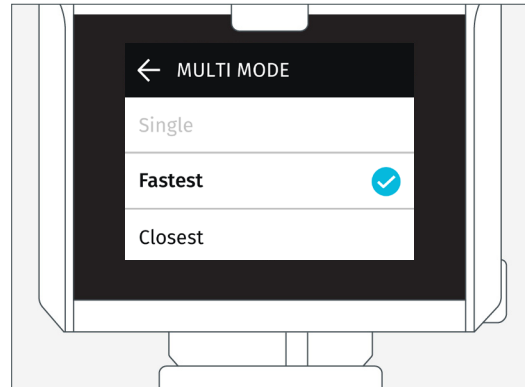
A. Select Tags

- Enter the Tag Manager
- Toggle tracking on for ALL Tags that you would like to track



B. Multi Mode

- Select Multi Mode.
- Exit the Tag Manager by tapping the Back Arrow (←).
- Proceed to calibration and begin tracking.





Scenario: Track a Single Tag from Multiple Camera

Requirements

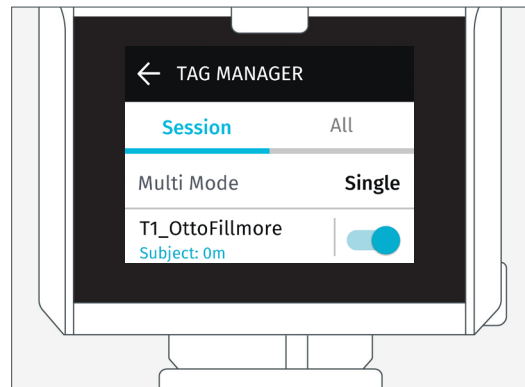
- The Tag that you'd like to track in the session must be saved to all Cameras.
- If the Tags are not saved, see TROUBLESHOOTING above.

A. Select Tag

- From the Track App on all Cameras, tap the Tag Icon ().
- Ensure that tracking is toggled on ().

B. Multi Mode

- Multi Mode does not apply here as there is only one Tag in the system.
- Exit the Tag Manager by tapping the Back Arrow (←).
- Proceed to calibration and begin tracking.





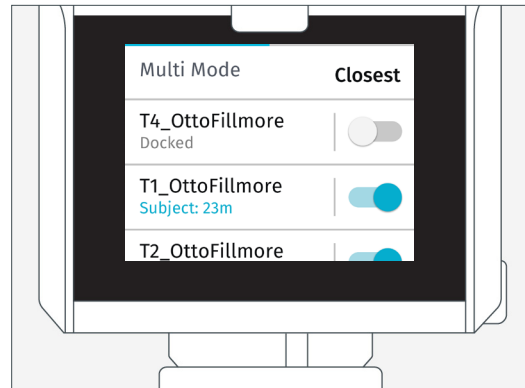
Scenario: Track Multiple Tags from Multiple Cameras

Requirements


- The Tags that you'd like to track in the session must already be saved to each Camera.
- If the Tags are not saved, see TROUBLESHOOTING above.

Select Tags

- From the Track App on all Cameras, tap the Tag Icon ().
- Ensure that tracking is toggled on for all Tags, on all Cameras ().



Multi Mode

- Select Multi Mode.
- Multi Modes can be different on each Camera. Exit the Tag Manager by tapping the Back Arrow ().
- Proceed to calibration on each Camera Base and begin tracking.
