For several years, the Holy Spirit has led me to keep a War Binder. It is where I have safely stored record of my assignments when He has instructed me to go to war.

It is an honor to share some of what thy Lord has faithfully bestowed upon me while teaching my hands to war and my fingers to fight.

It is my prayer as you war thy Lord Jesus continue to grace you with strength to defeat the enemy and walk in victory!

Let's start first with the creation of your War Binder:

Step One

Purchase a three-ring clear view Binder from your favorite office supply store, e.g., Office Max, Office Depot or Staples. Make sure the Binder says: "Clear View Binder" on the front or side of the Binder. You want to be sure to include a personalized cover for your War Binder. If you find it challenging envisioning a cover for your War Binder ask the Holy Spirit to bestow you with His vision. He will answer you!

Step Two

Now, let's continue to Creating Tabs.

Before we continue on to this step, let's pray and ask the Holy Spirit how would He like your War Binder interior to be created.

Blessed Holy Spirit, we thank You for Your Presence. Lord, we ask You to continue to be our guide as we create this War Binder for Your glory. Helper, we ask You to help us to bring order to our prayer assignments with the use of this War Binder. Grace us to be faithful and trustworthy with the assignments You have graciously given to us to steward in this Earth Realm. We decree Matthew 6:9-13 over our prayer assignments. Lord thank you for guiding us as we create it to give you the glory! In Jesus Name, Amen.

Now, I thought it would also be helpful to you if I provided a sample of what tabs are included in my War Binder to further help as a guideline as you create your own.

Here is a sample of what the interior of my War Binder may consist of:

- 1. Praise & Thanksgiving
- 2. Devotion
- 3. Assignments: (List of Names, ABC Church, ABC Ministries, Lily State)
- 4. Listing of each of the above assignments would have their own respective tab.

For example: I have a leader named Bishop John Doe who I am assigned to intercede for. I have included Bishop John Doe appropriately in my prayer assignments marked in the sample as "Assignments". Bishop John Doe would also have a separate Tab exclusively for him as listed in point "4."

Inside of Bishop John Doe's Tab I might include:

Dates of prayer, scriptures, instructions, Word of Knowledge, Praise Reports and anything thy Lord has spoken to me about my prayer assignment concerning Bishop John Doe.

- 5. Answered Prayers
- 6. Gratitude
- 7. Notes

Step Three

Paper: Regular 8 x 11 Loose-leaf paper is what I would suggest you use for your writing.

There are some online retailers that sell blank and printable inserts that can be used for a prayer journal and war binders which you may find more useful. However, I have included this suggestion to provide you with a sample that would best fit my assignments.

Be encouraged, warriors! Thy Holy Spirit is faithful to continue to give assignments when we walk in discretion and faithfulness in our intercession ministry.

And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus. Ephesians 2:6

As a warrior, you must fight seated in Heavenly Places. Listen to your favorite praise music as you dance and praise the King of Glory just as King David. Warrior, release your praise to Jehovah Gibbor to execute vengeance upon the heathen and punishments upon the people; to bind their kings with chains and their nobles with fetters of iron; to execute upon them the judgment written: this honour have all his saints. Psalm 149.

Praise & Worship

God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth. John 4:24

The heart of a true worshipper seeks to please the lover of his/her soul: Our Savior, Lord and Father. The most profound revelation of presenting ourselves as a living sacrifice holy unto the Lord is inscribed in Romans 12:1:

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present ye bodies as a living sacrifice, holy unto God, which is your reasonable service.

The Bible admonishes us to present gifts unto thy Lord when we bow down to worship thy Bread of Life:

And when they were come into the house, they saw the Young Child, with Mary, His Mother and fell down, and worshipped Him: and when they opened their treasures, they presented unto Him gifts; gold, frankincense and myrrh. Matthew 2:11

Warriors, we must be clothed in the garment of humility before entering the enemy's terrain to war. As it is written in the First Book of Peter, chapter five verse five:

Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.

The most beautiful attribute and grace as Children of the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the God of our fathers is humility. When we examine our Lord's Heart of Service our eyes of understanding are opened to perceive His desire for His Children to acquire a servant and humble heart.

Let us remember, John 13:5, where we read:

After that He poured water into a basin, and began to wash His disciples feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith He was girded.

Our Blessed Savior also expounded to Peter about humility as written in the Gospel of John 13:8.

Hearing the Voice of God

This is the generation of them that seek Him, that seek thy face, O Jacob. Psalm 24:6

As Children of God, our first love must be fellowshipping and seeking our Heavenly Father. Reading the Word of God, worshipping and obedience unto thy Lord will open our hearts to hear the still small voice of God for His strategic instructions given to war. We must never enter into warfare without the guidance of the Holy Spirit. I implore you never to enter into war the Holy Spirit has not legislated for you.

Take fast the instructions that the Holy Spirit gives you to go to war. Hear His counsel and receive His instructions, keep notes and meditate on it during your quiet time that thou might be wise. Proverbs 4:13, Proverbs 19:20

I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye. Psalm 32:8
