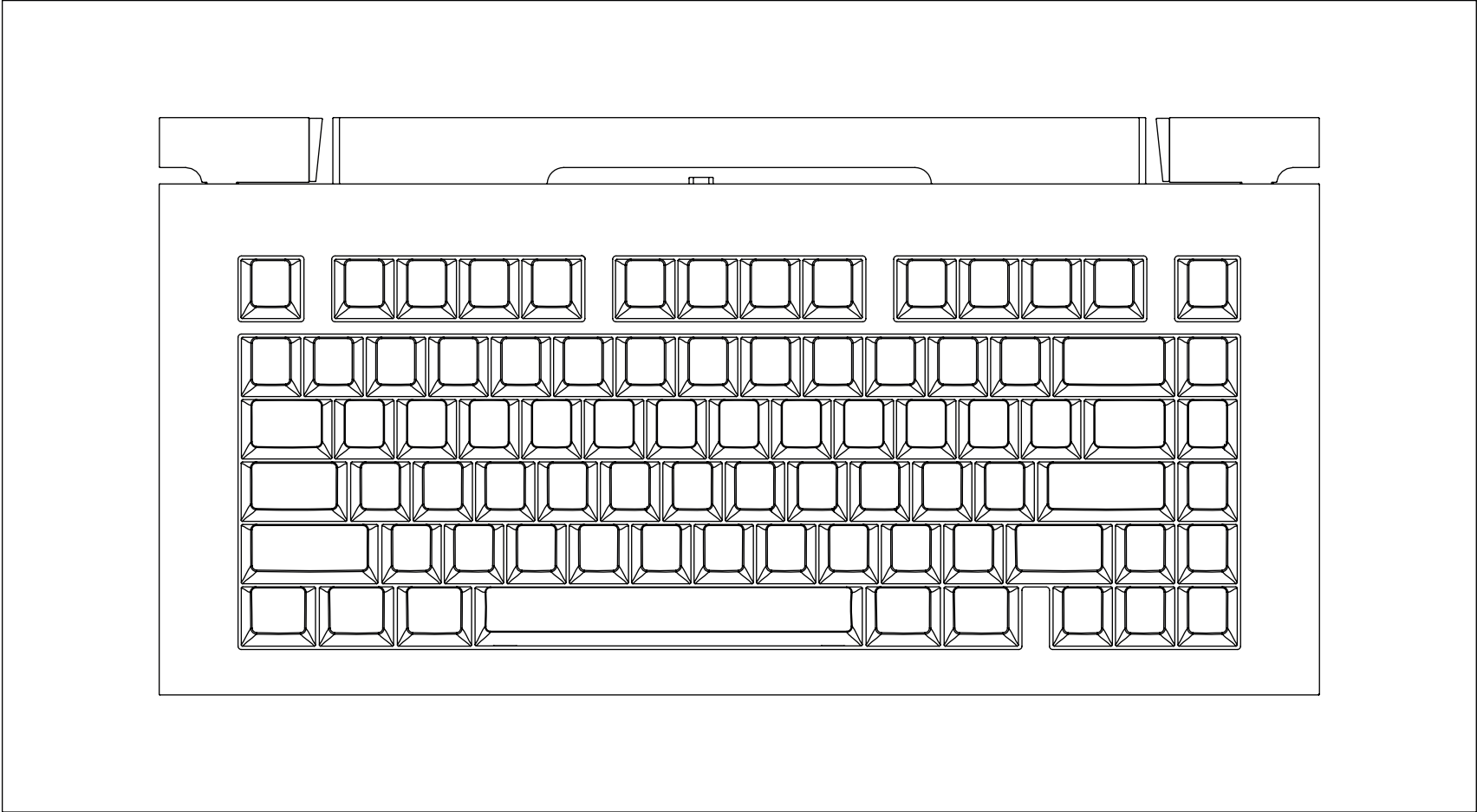

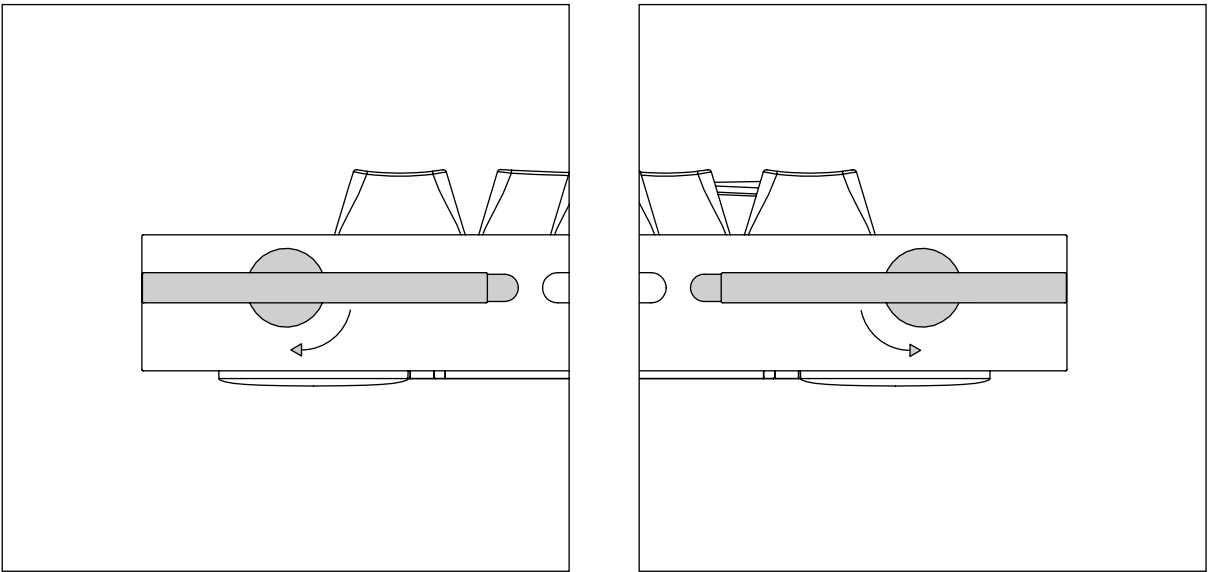
1. Hardware overview



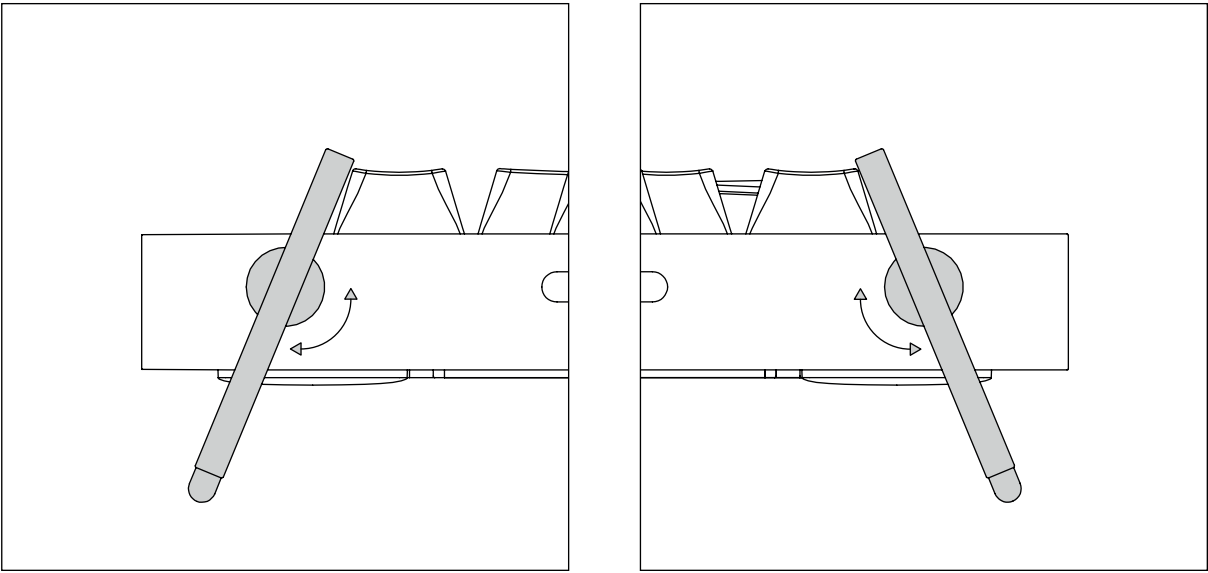
Slate 75 is a mechanical keyboard, featuring a 75% layout optimized for productivity. Designed with a zero-degree typing angle in mind, it includes a twist-to-tilt mechanism that adjusts to a 5.5-degree angle for comfort.

It offers seamless compatibility with both Mac and Windows systems, easily switching between them with a simple selector switch. The interface connection is via USB-C.

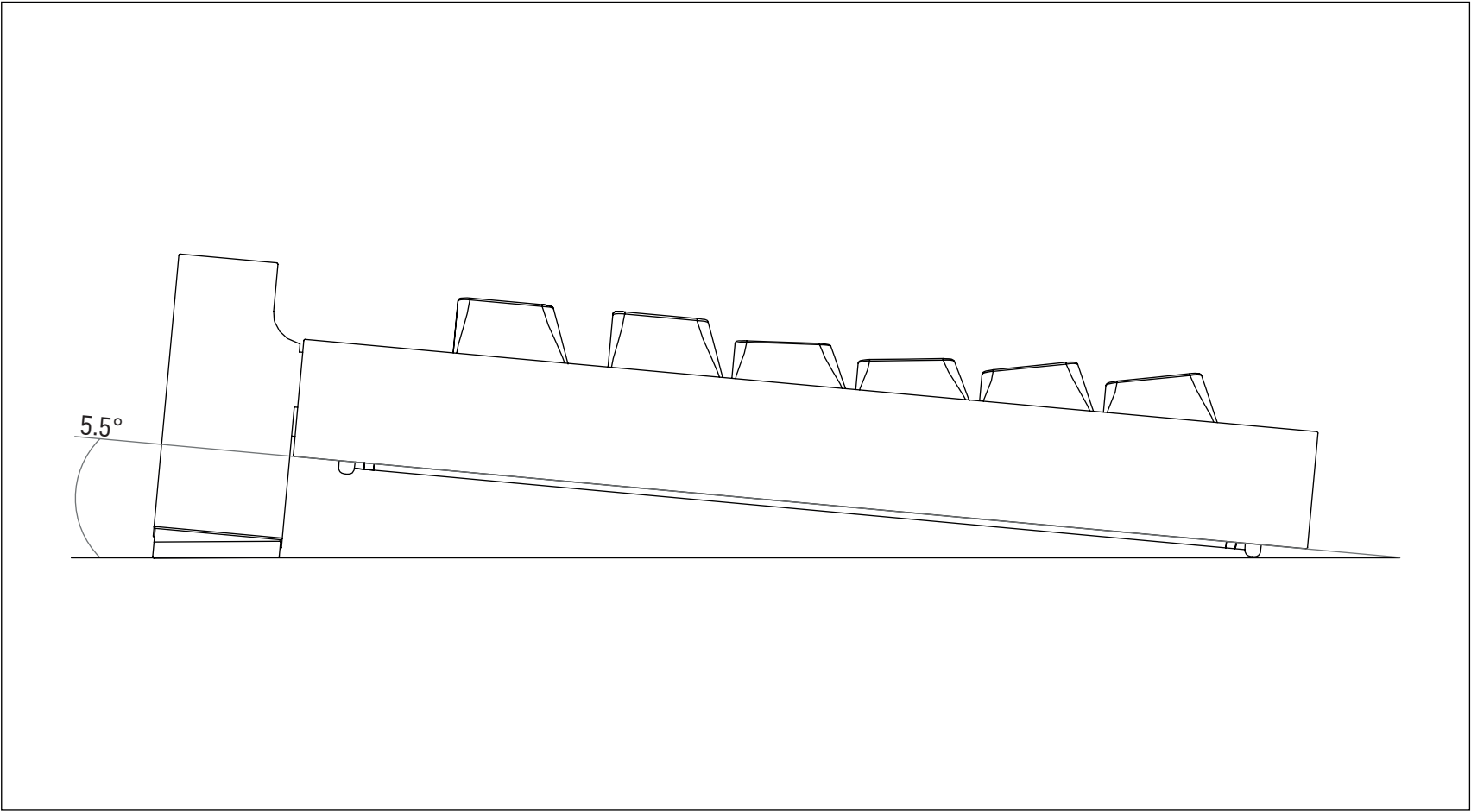
2. Twist to tilt



To adjust the keyboard to a 5.5 degree typing angle, twist the left and right mechanisms outward as shown in the diagram.

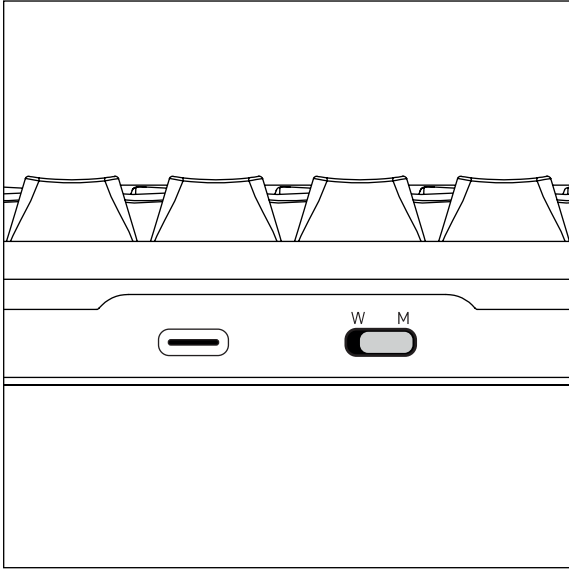


To return the keyboard back to zero degree, twist the mechanism in the opposite direction.



2. Switching between Mac and Windows

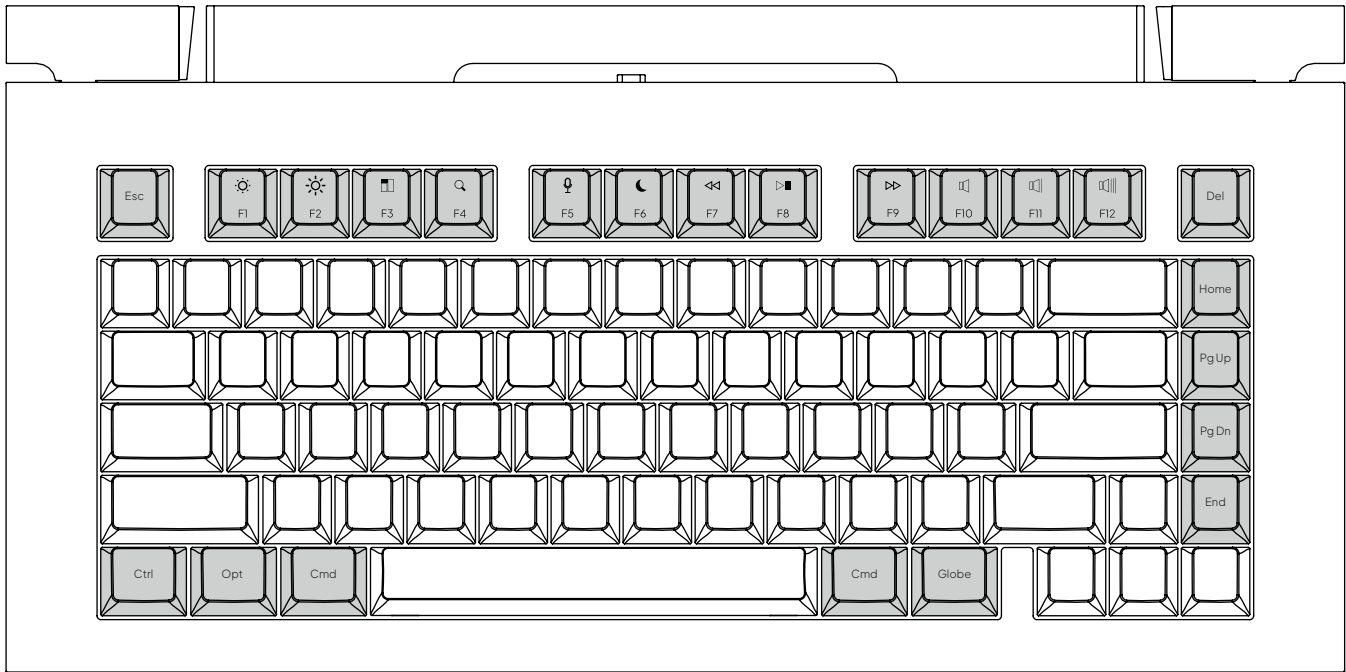
Mac and Windows each have unique function and modifier keys.



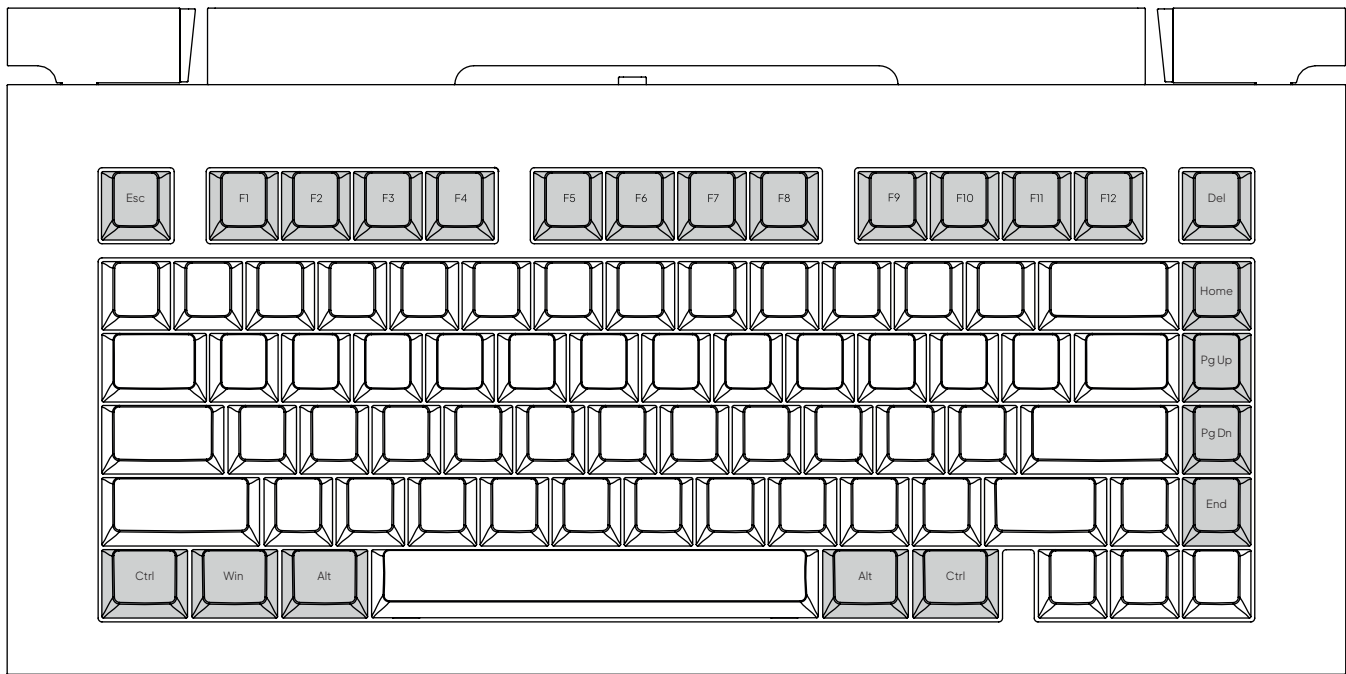
To switch between Mac and Windows, toggle the switch to the right for Mac or to the left for Windows.
