


- 1 Remove all contents from the package. Set the humidifier base (b) in an accessible area next to your terrarium or enclosure.
- 2 Before using, unscrew the valve on the black bottom of the humidifier tank (a) and rinse out the tank with a small amount of mild dish soap. Rinse well, until no more soapy water comes out when rinsing.
- 3 Fill the humidifier tank (a) with up to 2 liters of water by unscrewing black protruding. Re-screw valve until hand tight.
- Y Place humidifier tank (a) on base (b). It should fit well and will be secure. If it is not, make sure that it is aligned in the proper orientation.
- 5 Place the larger end of the extendable hose (c) on the black neck of the humidifier tank (a) that should now be standing upright.
- Extend the hose (c) and place the end in/on the top or side of the terrarium facing inwards. Move the suction cups down the hose and stick them on to the side of the terrarium. NOTE: The hose should not have slumps where water can pool, this may harm the fogger fan.
- 7 Plug in the unit. Adjust the dial on the front of the unit to the desired output. It may take a few seconds for output to increase/decrease after you have adjusted the dial.
- 8 Refill the unit as necessary. Enjoy!





- 1 Unscrew knob on the left (d).
- 2 Fill with over 1-liter distilled water.
- 3 Screw knob on.
- Y Flip the tank over and place it on the black base.
- 5 Wait 10 seconds, then turn on.
