

Jr. Joyrider **Assembly Instruction**

1.Preparation

Remove all parts from the carton. Do not remove protective wrapping until necessary.

Check tire air pressure and inflate to 35psi. Make sure tires are properly seated on rims.

2.Seat Assembly

Install seat Jr. Joyrider (74) to the base Jr. Joy seat/basket (25) using bolts (73), (52), spacers (72) and nut (33). Be sure to tighten all nuts connecting. (see figure 1.)

Slide the seat & basket assembly over the frame rail and adjust the side lever for the operator's best leg and arm position (see figure 2.)

3. Handlebars

Remove two carriage bolts (44) and nuts (10) from the handlebar assembly. Insert the handlebar assembly into the two brackets at the front of the frame, and secure with the bolts (44) and nuts (10). Adjust the handlebar for the best position

(handlebar should be tight but able to move forward and backward to allow for easy entry and exit).


4. Handbrake

Before riding, roll the Jr. Joyrider back and forth and apply the brake lever. If the stopping action is not quick, tighten brake cable by loosening the nut on the bottom of the adjusting barrel (55) and turning the adjusting barrel clockwise (see figure 3). Once the braking action is firm, tighten the nut and adjusting barrel.

The brake lever may be set by pulling back the brake lever, pushing down the spring loaded button, and releasing the lever; the button should stay in the pressed position. To return brake to its normal position, pull back brake lever – allowing the button to pop-up and release the lever.

5. Final Check

Complete by installing rear red and front clear reflectors on places (see figure 1.and Illustrated Parts Breakdown), safety flag (4) in the holder. Review the instruction, check connecting bolts and screws for tightness, and readjusting the seat and handlebar as necessary.

REGULAR MAINTENANCE: Bi-Monthly

- 1. Keep all painted parts cleaned and waxed for along-lasting luster.
- 2. Lubricate the following:
 - Axle shafts
 - Chain- turn pedal crank forward and spray freely.
- 3. When storing over prolonged periods, turn upside down to prevent flats from occurring on the tires. If stored outside, cover to protect finish and moving parts.

PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE: Every Six Months

These are services that should be performed by you local bicycle shop. A fee may be charged.

- 1. Check tires for wear, rim cuts and valve core alignment (usually caused by improper air pressure)
- 2. Check wheels for cracks and alignment.
- 3. Check brakes for proper operation.
- 4. Check and repack all bearings and adjust all cones.
- 5. Check for worn bearings, cones and cups.
- 6. Check chain for adjustment and clean as needed.
- 7. Check for loose bolts and nuts.

Attention: While your unit is new, some noises may occur when the unit is breaking in. Should they continue for more than 30 days, see local bike shop.

INSPECTION

Check the following, as it applies to your cycle, on a regular basis:

- 1. Hand Brake: Make sure the brake engages, by squeezing the hand brake.
- 2. Wheels: Check wheels for alignment.
- 3. Pedals: Inspect pedals and make sure pedals are tightly attached to crank.
- 4. Handle grips: Replace worn or loose grips.
- 5. Chain: Check for proper tightness. Replace damaged chain immediately.
- 6. Seat: Adjust seat for ride comfort and safety.
- 7. Tires: Keep tires inflated to the recommended tire pressure, as indicated on the tire's sidewall.
- 8. Frame: Replace damaged frame immediately.

JR. JOY RIDER

This is a recreational unit, not designed for excessive speeds or misuse.

Do not brake or turn at high speeds. This may cause cycle to roll over. Careless operation may cause rider to lose control and result in **serious injury**.

Things to know before riding your cycle:

- 1. Know your local bicycle laws and wear a helmet.
- 2. Do not exceed the recommended weight limit of 150 lbs.
- 3. No more than one rider at one time.
- 4. Do not stand on unit.
- 5. Be sure to install safety flags.
- 6. Wear light-colored clothing and protective gear.
- 7. Do not ride at night.
- 8. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.

Trailmate Limited Warranty

Trailmate, Inc., guarantees each cycle product against all defects in materials and workmanship for a period of 90 days from date of purchase. Tires and tubes are not covered by this guarantee.

During this period, any part that is judged by the makers to be defective will be replaced free of charge. Any failure resulting from accident, abuse, neglect, normal wear, or improper assembly or maintenance by the owner is not covered.

Trailmate, Inc., further authorizes a lifetime frame guarantee and will replace any frame, at no cost to the buyer, providing that item has not been used for rental use and that:

- 1) The item has not been altered, repaired, or modified in any way.
- 2) The item has not been subject to misuse, negligence, and/or an accident.
- 3) Original ownership is established.

Any parts under this guarantee on which claims are entered shall be returned for inspection with transportation charges prepaid by the claimant. Replacement parts will be shipped F.O.B. factory.
