Dear Outfitter Satellite Customer:

Effective May 1, 2016, we will be discontinuing the **US Based Number** access option for all **Inmarsat GSPS** and **Inmarsat BGAN** postpaid service plans. This optional service which costs \$9.95 per month is identified as *US BASED NUMBER - ISAT* and *US BASED NUMBER - BGAN* on your monthly (or annual) invoice. Your monthly service fee will continue without change, only the above mentioned US Based Number option will be terminated on May 1, 2016. Your April 2016 Invoice will be the last invoice on which you will see the service fee though airtime usage can sometimes bill up to 90 days in arrears for some customers.

After May 1, 2016, we will launch a new US Number option service for Inmarsat postpaid service plans. Unfortunately, the new service will be significantly higher in cost with a rate of \$4.50 per minute and a monthly charge of \$15 per month. Any customer needing a US Number access for inbound voice calls to their Inmarsat GSPS or Inmarsat BGAN should contact us if the new service would be useful for them.
