It is designed for use in periodontal surgery, implantology, sinus elevation and tooth extraction sites to stop bleeding and augment soft tissue regeneration. Curagen® wound dressing is made of non-crosslinked bovine Achilles tendons and available in various plug and sheet configurations.

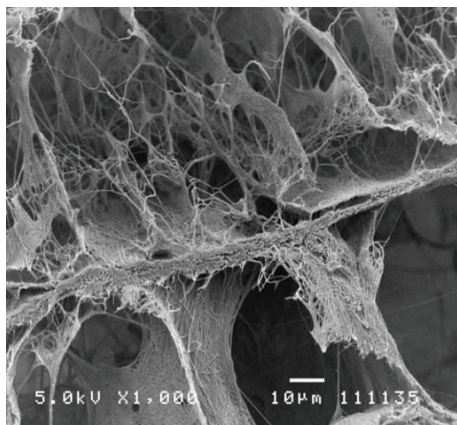


Available Sizes

Supplied in a sterile package, with varying configurations including:

- 10 x 20 mm plug
- 15 x 20 mm plug
- 20 x 40 x 3mm sheet
