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## CHEVRON STRIPES BABY BLANKET

EP82

A playful, striped baby blanket in Garter Stitch Chevron. The easy to memorize pattern makes for a fun knit that works up quickly.

**DESIGNED BY:** Trish Campbell

**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:**  
24" x 31.5"

### MATERIALS:

- 1 skein each in 4 colours (A, B and C) in Estelle Chunky, 50% Acrylic, 40% Wool, 10% Nylon  
Approx. 100g and 125m per ball  
Shown in Colour A: Lagoon (63350)  
Colour B: Limoncello (63318)  
Colour C: Lavender (63352)  
Colour D: Aqua (63351)
- Circular needle 6 mm (US 10.5), 32" or longer
- Tapestry needle

### GAUGE:

14 sts and 20 rows = 10cm (4")

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**k** - knit  
**p** - purl  
**rep** – repeat  
**rs** – right side  
**sl** - slip  
**sts** - stitches  
**wyif** - with yarn in front

### GLOSSARY:

**kfb** - knit into the front and back of the next st.  
1 st increased

**k2tog** - knit 2 together. 1 st decreased

**ssk** – slip the next two sts, one at a time, as if to knit; insert the tip of the left needle, from left to right, into the fronts of those two sts, and knit them together. 1 st decreased

### Chevron Pattern #1:

**Rows 1, 3, 5 & 7 (rs):** Sl 1 wyif, K2, \*k2tog, k2, kfb, kfb, k3, ssk. Rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3.

**Row 2, 4, 6 & 8:** Sl 1 wyif, k2, p to last 3 sts, k3.

### Chevron Pattern #2:

**Row 1 (rs):** Sl 1 wyif, K2, \*k2tog, k2, kfb, kfb, k3, ssk. Rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3.

**Rows 2 - 8:** Sl 1 wyif, knit to end of row.

### Instructions

Using Colour A, loosely cast on 96 sts.

**Rows 1-7:** Sl 1 wyif, knit to end of row. Break A.

Using Colour B, work Chevron Pattern #1.  
Break B.

Using Colour C, work Chevron Pattern #2.  
Break C.

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Continue alternating Chevron Pattern #1 and Chevron Pattern #2, changing colours at the beginning of each pattern in the following sequence:

Chevron Pattern #1 – Colour D.

Chevron Pattern #2 – Colour B.

Chevron Pattern #1 – Colour C.

Chevron Pattern #2 – Colour A.

Chevron Pattern #1 – Colour B.

Chevron Pattern #2 – Colour D.

Chevron Pattern #1 – Colour A.

Chevron Pattern #2 – Colour C.

Chevron Pattern #1 – Colour D.

Chevron Pattern #2 – Colour B.

Chevron Pattern #1 – Colour A.

Chevron Pattern #2 – Colour D.

Chevron Pattern #1 – Colour C.

Chevron Pattern #2 – Colour B.

Chevron Pattern #1 – Colour D.

Chevron Pattern #2 – Colour A.

Cast off loosely in Colour A.

Weave in ends.

Block to measurements.
