



EVENTIDE HAT AND COWL

EP133

A quick and easy hat and cowl with lace details, that makes the perfect last-minute gift!

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Hat Circumference: 50-60cm (20-24")

Hat Height: 21.6cm (8.5") Cowl Circumference: 56cm (22") Cowl Height: 17.75cm (7")

MATERIALS

1 ball of Estelle Ripple, Approx. 200g/140m

6mm (US 10) 40cm (16") Circular needle

8mm (US 11) 40cm (16" Circular needle

8mm (US 11) Double pointed needles

1 stitch marker

1 darning needle

Optional: One Estelle Snap On Pompom

GAUGE

11 sts and 15 rows = 10cm/4" in Stockinette St. using 8mm (US 11) needles

ABBREVIATIONS

k - knit

k1tbl - knit 1 through back loop

k2tog - knit 2 together

kfb - knit through the front, then again through the back of the same stitch (1 st inc)

p - purl

p2tog - purl the next two sts together

pm - place marker

rep - repeat

skp - slip one stitch knit-wise, knit the next stitch, then pass the slipped stitch over that stitch

sk2p - slip one stitch knit-wise, knit the next two stitches together, pass the slipped stitch over

sts - stitches **yo** - yarn over

HAT

With 6mm (US 10) circular needles, cast on 54 stitches, join to work in the round, being careful not to twist your sts

TWISTED RIB BRIM

*K1tbl, p1; rep from * to end of round.
Repeat Twisted Rib round 5 more times (6 rounds total).

INCREASE ROUND

With 8mm (US 11) circular needles: *K8, kfb; rep from * to end of round (60 sts).

LACE PATTERN

R1: *Yo, skp, k8; rep from * to end of round.
R2 and all even rounds: Knit to end of round.

R3: *K1, yo, skp, k5, k2tog, yo; rep from * to end of round.

R5: *K2, yo, skp, k3, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from * to end of round.

R7: *K5, yo, skp, k3; rep from * to end of round.

R9: *K3, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, skp, k2; rep from * to end of round.

R11: *K2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, skp, k1; rep from * to end of round.

R12: Knit to end of round.

Repeat Lace Pattern once more (2 times total).

DECREASE ROUNDS

Note: Switch to double pointed needles as necessary.

R1: K3, pm; this marker will be the new beginning of round, *skp, k1, k2tog; rep from * to end of round (36 sts).

R2: Knit to end of round.

R3: *Sk2p; rep from * to end of round (12 sts).

R4: Knit to end of round.

Leaving a 7 inch tail, break yarn and weave through 12 remaining stitches. Pull tight to close the top of the hat. Weave in all ends and block as desired.

If using one of our Snap On Pompoms, sew the snap to the top of the hat using sewing thread or embroidery floss in a matching colour.

COWL

With 6mm (US 10) circular needles, cast on 60 stitches, join to work in the round, being careful not to twist your sts.

TWISTED RIB TRIM

*K1tbl, p1; rep from * to end of round.
Repeat Twisted Rib round 2 more times (3 rounds total).

Next Round: Using 8mm (US 11) circular needles, knit to end of round.

LACE PATTERN

R1: *Yo, skp, k8; rep from * to end of round.
R2 and all even rounds: Knit to end of round.

R3: *K1, yo, skp, k5, k2tog, yo; rep from * to end of round.

R5: *K2, yo, skp, k3, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from * to end of round.

R7: *K5, yo, skp, k3; rep from * to end of round.

R9: *K3, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, skp, k2; rep from * to end of round

R11: *K2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, skp, k1; rep from * to end of round.

R12: Knit to end of round.

Repeat Lace Pattern once more (2 times total).

Using 6mm (US 10) circular needles, repeat Twisted Rib Trim round 3 more times.

Bind off loosely as follows:

*P2tog, place the resulting stitch back on the left hand needle, repeat from * until one st remains. Break yarn and thread through final stitch.

Weave in ends, and block as desired.
