



QUICK CHUNKY HAT

EP132

A fast and fun hat that uses slipped stitches to create interesting texture.

SKILL LEVEL: Easy

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference, Unstretched 40cm / 16" Height 19cm / 7.5"

MATERIALS

 1 skein of Estelle Eco Scandinavian Bulky Approx. 200g and 120m per ball Shown in Colour 01 – Natural (Note: One skein will make two hats)

- 9mm (US 13) 40cm (16") Circular needle
- 9mm (US 13) Double pointed needles
- One jumbo stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE

10 sts and 16 rounds = 10cm / 4" in stockinette

ABBREVIATIONS

k - knit

p - purl

K2tog - Knit two stitches together

P2tog - Purl two stitches together

SI1 - slip the next stitch purl-wise, with yarn in back

Sts - stitches

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 40 sts. Place a marker, and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist.

Ribbing Round

(K1, P1) to end of round.

Repeat Ribbing Round 4 more times.

R1-R2: Knit

R3: (P1, Sl1, P1, Sl1, P4) to end of round. R4: (P1, Sl1, P1, Sl1, P4) to end of round.

Repeat R1-R4, 5 more times.

Note: If you prefer a taller hat, you may repeat R1-R4 two more times, but you won't be able to get two hats out of one ball.

R5-R6: Knit to end of round.

Decrease Rounds

Switch to double pointed needles as necessary.

R7: (P1, Sl1, P1, Sl1, P2tog, P2tog) to end of round. (30 sts)

R8: (P1, Sl1, P1, Sl1, P2) to end of round.

R9: (K2, K2tog, K2tog) to end of round. (20 sts)

R10: Knit to end of round.

R11: P2tog to end of round. (10 sts)

Break yarn, and thread through remaining stitches. Draw together tightly, and weave in ends. Wet block to shape.
