



RIBBED COWLET

EP80

This pattern is the combination of both cowl + capelet = "Cowlet". The design features a yarn over section that is knit flat, then joined to knit 1x1 rib in the round.

SKILL LEVEL: Easy

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference $40 \text{ cm} / 32^{"}$ Height $32 \text{ cm} / 12\%{"}$

MATERIALS

- 1 skein of CASCADE SPUNTANEOUS 100% extra fine merino wool Approx 200 g and 100 m per skein Shown in colour: 20 (Doeskin) and 04 (Red)
- Circular needle 12 mm / US 17, 80 cm / 32"
 long or size to obtain gauge
- 1 stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE

8% sts and 11 rounds = 10 cm / 4" in 1x1 rib stitch, blocked.

ABBREVIATIONS

k — knit

 \mathbf{p} — purl

rep — repeat

St(s) — stitch(es)

K2tog — together

yo — yarn over

* — repeat instructions following the single asterisks as directed

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 49 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, *yo, k2tog; rep from * to last 3 sts, yo,

k2tog, k1.

Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 a total of ten times.

Next row: *P1, k1; rep from * to last st, turn work so first and last st are facing, p the last and first st together to begin working in the round. Place marker for the beginning.

Next round: *K1, p1; rep from * to end of round. Repeat last round until rib measures 18 cm / 6.5".

Cast off loosely in pattern.

FINISHING

Block to finish, weave in ends.
