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# COLOUR BLOCK SHAWL

EP46

Using Estelle Alpaca Merino Bulky and large needles, this asymmetrical triangular shawl knits up quickly to provide a warm and luxurious shawl that explores different textures and colours.

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width 216 cm / 85"  
Height 96.5 cm / 39"

## MATERIALS

- 1 skein each in three colours  
Estelle Alpaca Merino Bulky,  
60% Alpaca, 40% Merino Wool  
Approx 200g and 150m per ball  
Shown in Colour A: 612 Lagoon, Colour B  
614 Plum, Colour C: 602 Black  
OR Estelle Bulky  
50% Wool, 40% Acrylic, 10% Nylon  
Shown in Colour A: 503 – Silver, Colour  
B: 504 Steel, Colour C: 526 French Navy
- Circular needle 12.0mm / US 17, 80 cm /  
32" or longer
- Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

6 sts and 10 rows = 10 cm / 4" in stockinette  
stitch, blocked

## ABBREVIATIONS

**k** - knit

**p** - purl

**M1R** - With LH needle pick up strand between  
last stitch and the next stitch, from the back,  
then with the RH needle, knit into this from the  
front.

**Sts** - stitches

## INSTRUCTIONS

Using Colour A, cast on 2 sts.

Knit one row.

**R1:** (RS) M1R, knit to end of row. (3 sts)

**R2:** (WS) Knit

Repeat R1 & R2, 3 more times (6sts)

## SECTION 1:

**R3:** (RS) K2, M1R, (K1, P1) to last 2 sts, K2

**R4:** (WS) K2, P1, (K1, P1) to last 2 sts, K2.

**R5:** K2, M1R, P1, (K1, P1) to last 2 sts, K2

**R6:** K2, (P1, K1) to last 2 sts, K2  
(8 sts)

Repeat R3-R6, 20 more times. (48 sts)

Repeat R3-R4, 1 more time. (49 sts)

Cut Colour A, leaving a 15cm / 6" tail, for  
weaving in later.

## SECTION 2:

Attach Colour B.

**R1:** K2, M1R, (K3, P1) to last 3 sts, K3

**R2:** K2, P2, (K1, P3) to last 2 sts, K2

**R3:** K2, M1R, K2, (P1, K3) to last 2 sts, K2

**R4:** K3, (P3, K1) to last 4 sts, P2, K2

**R5:** K2, M1R, K1, (P1, K3) to end of row

**R6:** K2, P2, K1, (P3, K1) to last 3 sts, P1, K2

**R7:** K2, M1R, ( P1, K3) to last 2 sts, K2

**R8:** K3, (P3, K1) to last 2sts, K2  
(53 sts)

Repeat R1-R8, 3 more times. (65 sts)

Repeat R1-R6, 1 more time. (68 sts)

Cut Colour B, leaving a tail as in Section 1.



## Colour Block Shawl

### SECTION 3:

#### Attach Colour C.

**R1:** K2, M1R, knit to end of row

**R2:** K2, purl to last 2 sts, K2

**R3:** K2, M1R, K1, (P2, K2) to last 2 sts, K2

**R4:** K2, (P2, K2) to end of row

**R5:** K2, M1R, knit to end of row

**R6:** K2, purl to last 2 sts, K2

**R7:** K2, M1R, P1, (K2, P2) to last 4 sts, K4

**R8:** K2, (P2, K2) to last 2 sts, K2  
(72 sts)

Repeat R1-R8, 2 more times. (80 sts)

Repeat R1-R2, 1 more time. (81 sts)

**R9:** K2, M1R, knit to end of row

**R10:** Knit to end of row  
(82 sts)

Repeat R9-R10, 1 more time. (83 sts)

With RS facing, bind off loosely.

Weave in ends, and wet block to shape.
