

Hazero Spill Kits – An Overview



What is a Spill Kit?

Spill kits deliver the ability to contain specific hazardous substance spills.

An effective spill kit will do that and provide confidence that, in the event of an emergency, its contents are appropriate for that spill, quick and easy to deploy, and stocked with action-ready contents that won't break down, or go "off" over time.

What do Spill Kits contain?

This depends on the type of kit.

Inside an effective spill kit you'll typically find:

- **Sorbent Pads:** for absorbing liquids on flat surfaces
- **Sorbent Socks:** for surrounding the spill and preventing it spreading further
- **Sorbent Pillows:** for plugging openings or placing under or around machinery
- **Loose Absorbent:** for absorbing liquids on rough surfaces. (Brush and pan included!)
- **PPE:** to protect the user during the response process
- **Hazardous waste bags:** to hold contaminated absorbents and used PPE
- Clear, concise, step-by-step instructions for use.

NOTE: Larger spill kits may also include drain protectors, leak putty, brooms, shovels, specific types of respirators, hard hats, and even safety footwear.

To reflect the extra duty of care demanded, these kits include; a Face Mask with P2 Valve, Spill Response Booklet with incident forms, Hazard Tape, Drum Plug, and a Drain Protector. This is the equipment responders need to be able not only to clean up and protect themselves, but to deal with wider aspects of fast-developing incidents, and then reporting, all with complete confidence. You can't ask for much more than that.

In 20L, 50L, 100L and 200L, for oil only spills, general purpose spills, and chemical spills. Refills available.
