INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- 1. Connect your power cable to the lamp then plug into a mains power socket. Turn the switch on at the back. The lamp is on charge and Also ready for use.
- 2. When the charging indicator is red, the recahrge option is activated and the power is on. When the blue lights are flashing the amp is charging. When the four blue bars are solid blue the lamp is fully charged.
- 3. Manual mode. Choose the curing time by pressing the chosen time button.
- 4. Automatic mode. Put the hand into the lamp and the lamp will automatically start.
- 5. The lamp has 10s, 30s and 60s timings. The lamp has 60s HIGH POWER function, for double strength higher heat curing, for fixing flies or crystals for example. The lamp has a 99s LOWER TEMPERATURE function with a lower heat, for those with sensitivity to heat spike. Choose your setting according to your product requirements.
- 6. Turn off and unplug the lamp when finished.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Keep the lamp away from water.
- Unplug when not in use. If you leave the lamp plugged in for long periods of time, you will find the recharge function doesn't last as long as expected, as it will constantly recharge the battery.
- Observe due diligence and regularly check the lamp and power cable/adaptor for signs of wear and tear. If damaged discontinue use immediately. Regular PAT testing is recommended, in accordance with local authority regulations.
- Do not use near children or allow children to operate the machine.
- Keep away from heat.
- Keep the lamp clean. To clean the lamp, turn the lamp off, disconnect from the power and clean the inside and outside with a damp cloth and disinfectant. Do not saturate. If there are tricky bits of gel to clean; use an ACETONE FREE cleanser to gently remove them. DO NOT USE ACETONE ON YOUR LAMP, it is NOT acetone resistant.
- Use the nail lamp ONLY for it's intended purpose as described in this user guide.
- For safety and to avoid rise of allergies, irritation and overexposure, ALWAYS cure gel products fully and according to the manufacturers instructions.
- Always apply gel products thinly to allow the light to penetrate fully.
- Ensure the hand is in the lamp straight to allow a full direct cure.
- Do not use with a different power cable.
