




Follow the instructions carefully to learn how to draw your own unicorn.
























Princess Symmetry

Instructions:

- 1. Print the drawing on the next page and fold lightly along the dotted line. Open the folded drawing.
- 2. Pour some child-safe paint into a tray. Use a paint brush or your fingers to paint the left side of the princesses' gown and body. Make sure the paint is not very runny.
- 3. Before the paint dries, fold the drawing in half as you did in step one and press lightly.
- 4. Pull the halves apart in seconds and let dry. Trace the dotted line with a marker.






















DIY Princess Tiara

Instructions:

- 1. Decorate the tiara template on the next page with markers, sequins or glitter.
- 2. Cut the template out and poke holes on either ends.
- 3. Tie two ribbons through each hole and get ready to wear your tiara!


















Roll A Unicorn!


Instructions:


- 1. Print out the unicorn features and the empty templates on the next four pages.
- 2. Use a standard numbered die to roll.

How to play?


- 1. Roll the die once for each feature. Eg: If you are rolling the die for 'eyes' and your die lands on 2, pick the second pair of eyes and place on your unicorn's face. There are six variations for each feature.
- 2. Cut out the correct numbered feature and paste it on the unicorn's face.












