AIMEE MELAUGH

Aimee Melaugh, based in Londonderry, graduated from the Ulster University Belfast with a First Class BA Honours in Fine Art.

Since then, Aimee has become one of Ireland's most exciting recent graduates. Although this is her first solo show at the ArtisAnn Gallery, her work has featured in a number of group shows, and is included in



several public collections, including the Belfast School of Art; The Arts Council of Northern Ireland's permanent collection; and the Northern Ireland Civil Service Art collection. She was recently shortlisted for the Robert Walter's UK New Artist of the Year Award in collaboration with Saatchi in London, and had her work exhibited at the Saatchi Gallery in 2021. She was also selected to appear in a group show at the MAC, Belfast, 2022.

Other recognitions include the Belfast Print Workshop Residency Award and the Royal Ulster Academy Award.

'Handful of Notes,' draws upon ideas surrounding identity, suppressed individuality, and deceiving appearances. The artist's work makes use of memento mori whilst depicting the malleable distortion of objects intertwined with desperate figures.

This is her first solo show at the ArtisAnn Gallery.



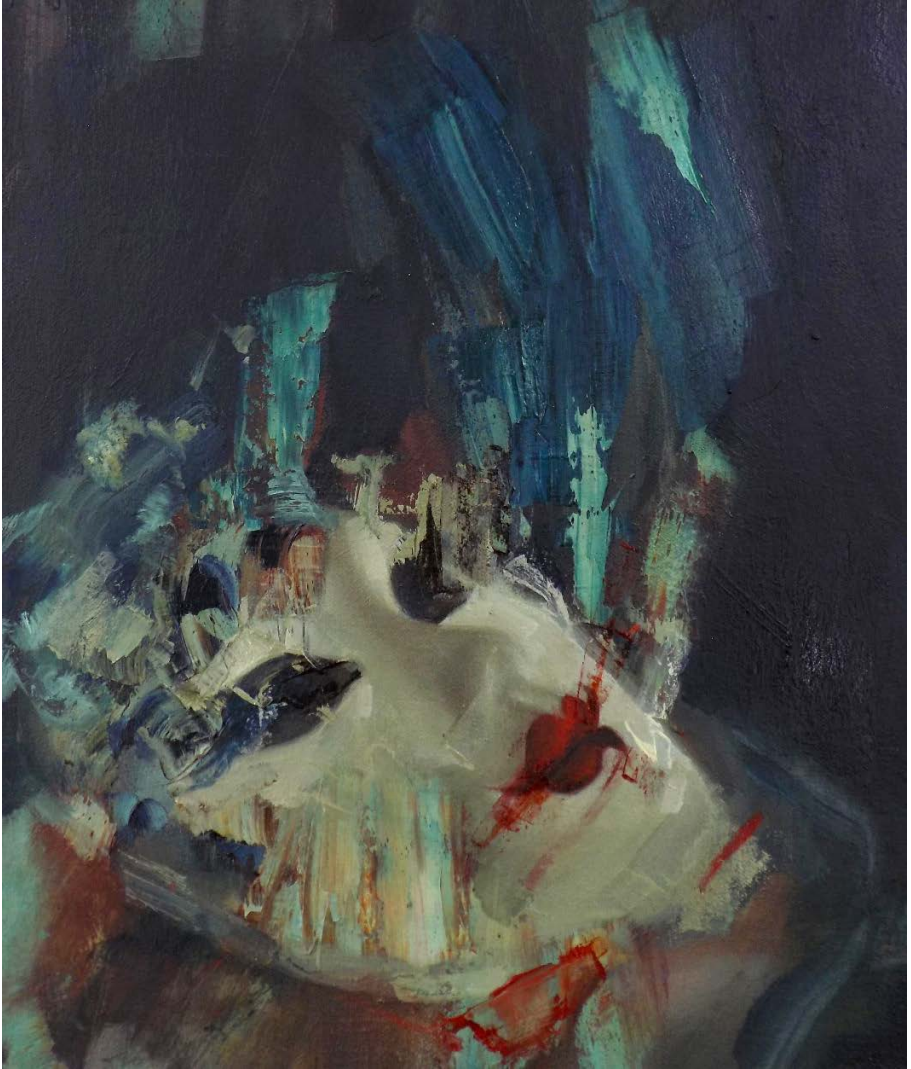
Ember, Oil on Canvas, 80 x 70 cms



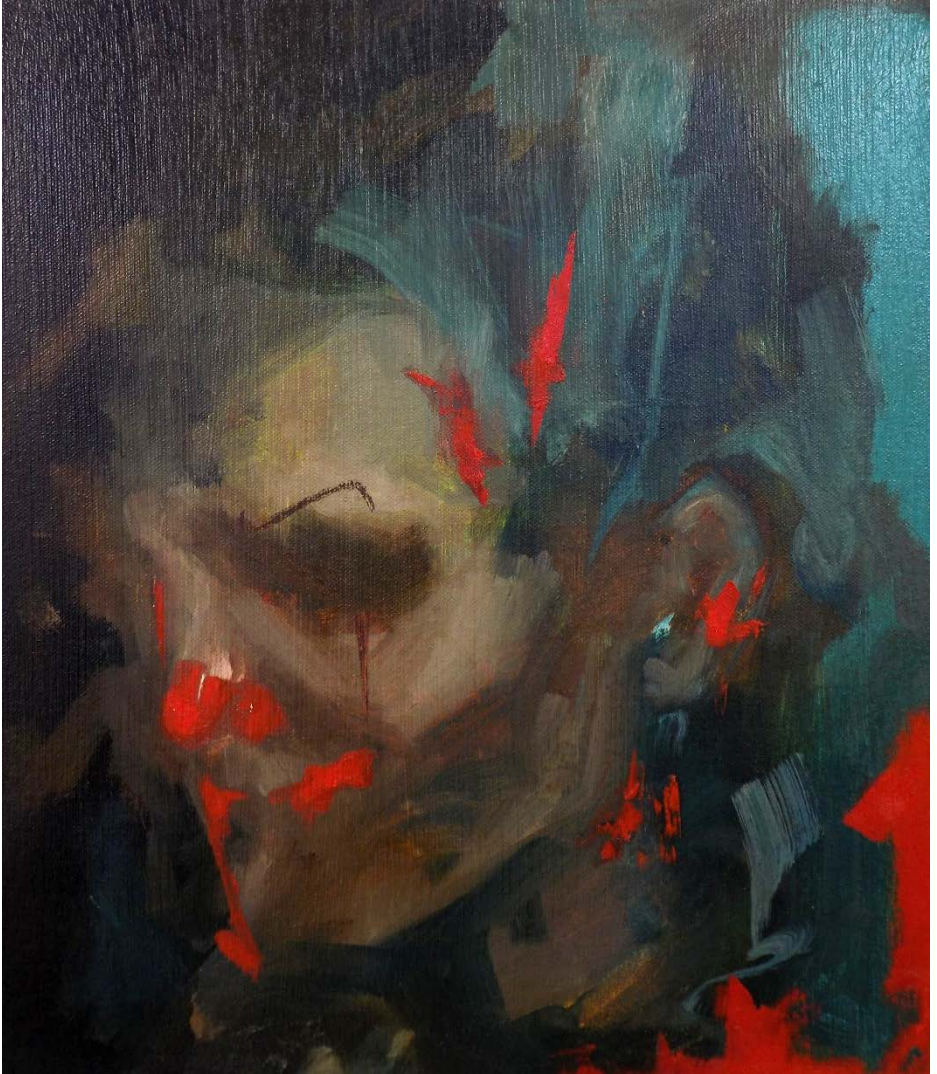
Rose Water, Oil on Canvas, 80 x 70 cms



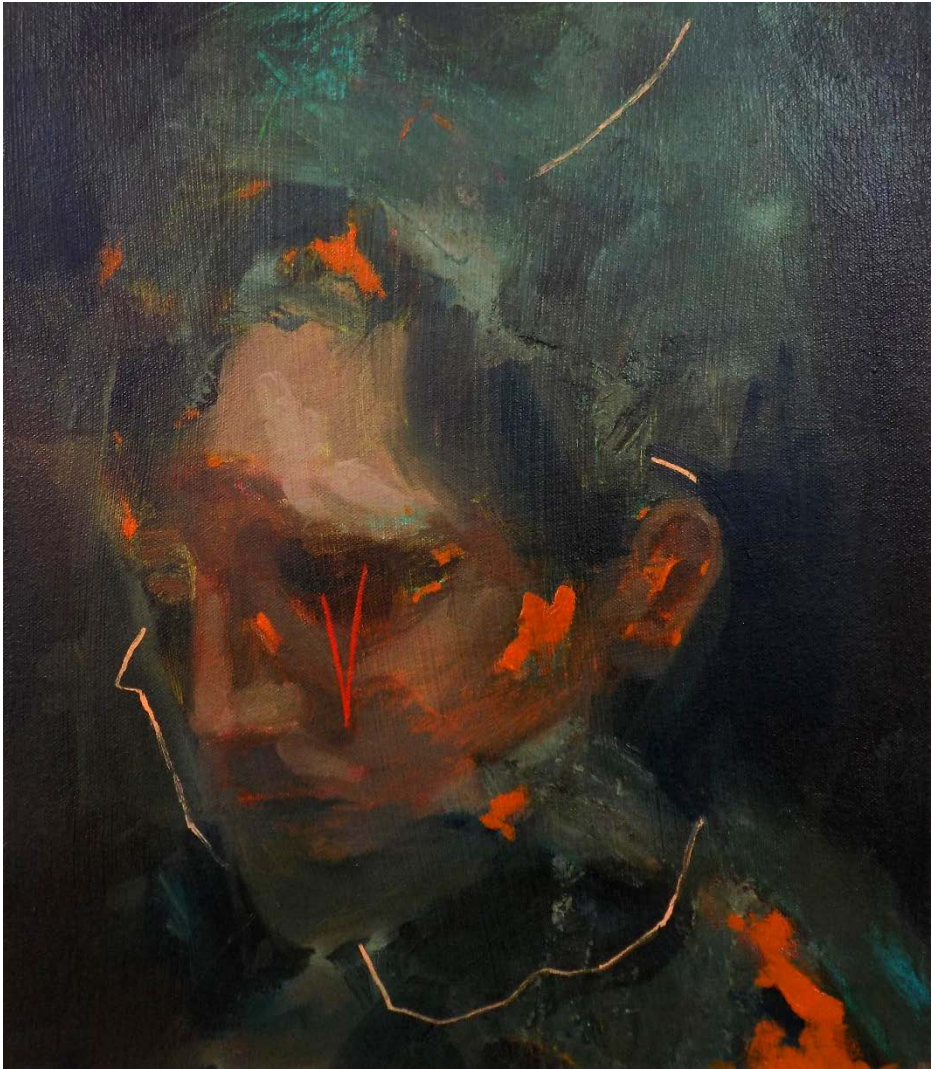
Present, Oil on Canvas, 45 x 40 cms



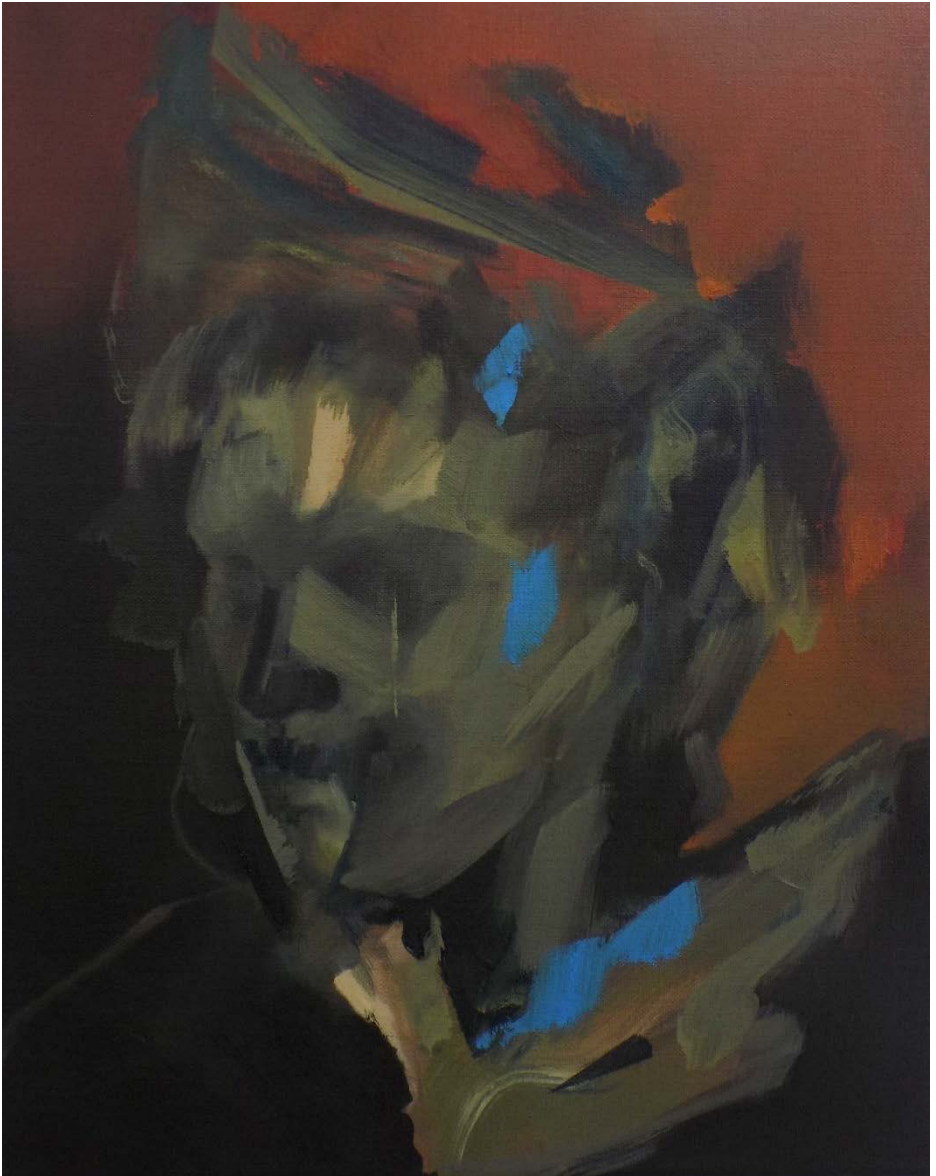
Perfected, Oil on Canvas, 35 x 30 cms

You need to be:

- Over 18
- UK Resident
- Employed, self-employed, or in receipt of a pension.

What do I need to apply?

- Photographic ID (driving licence, passport, etc.)
- Proof of address (utility bill, driving licence, etc.)
- Bank Account Direct Debit details (usually on your bank card)
- Employer/Pension details (name, address, phone no. or ref no.)

How long does it take?

Approximately 10 minutes to fill in the form either in the gallery or online at home – and, as you usually get approved straight away, you can bring your new artwork home immediately!

Is there a limit?

You can buy any original artwork from £100 to £10,000 from the ArtisAnn Gallery, including Prints and Sculptures. You pay over 10 months, starting four weeks after you sign up. You can even pay a deposit to make the monthly payments smaller!
