## **KAREN DAYE-HUTCHINSON, ARE, ARUA**

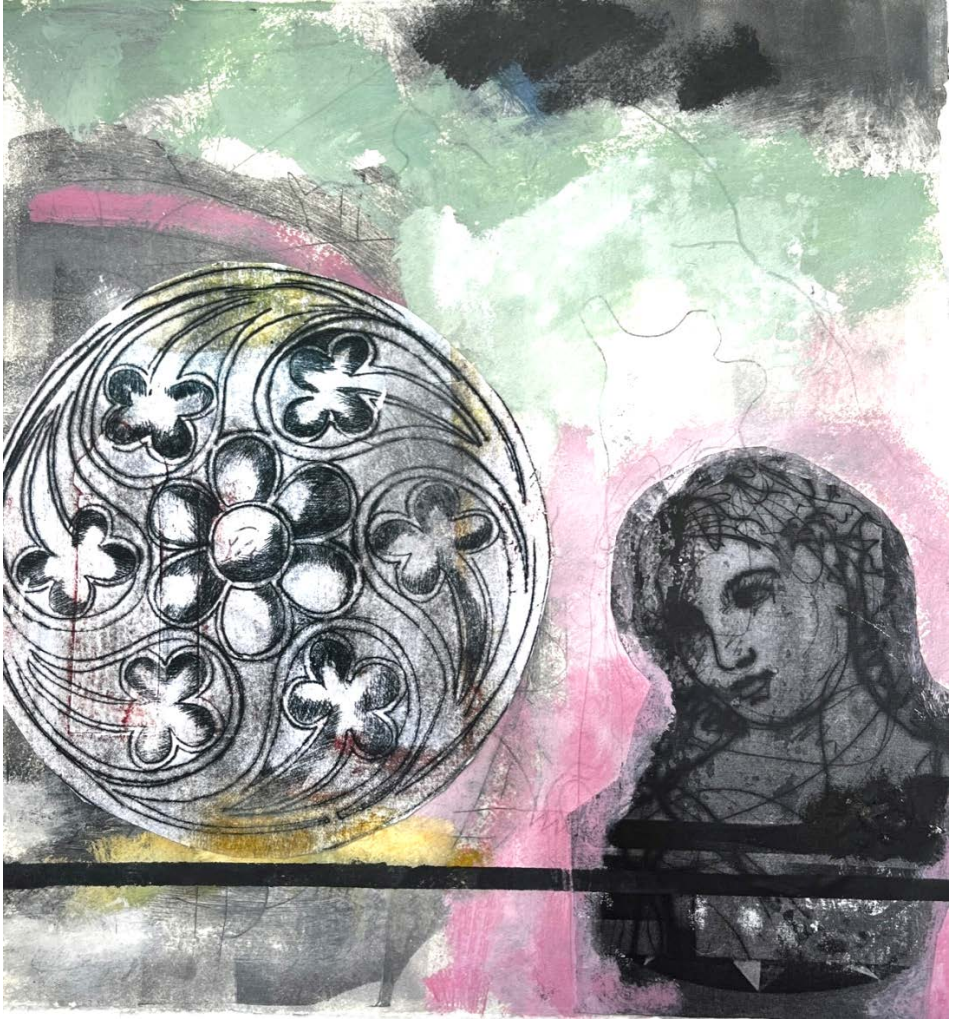
Belfast-born Karen completed a Diploma in Foundation Studies at Manchester Metropolitan University before completing a Fine Art degree at the University of Ulster in 1988. Since then, she has won numerous awards for her printmaking, including:



The HRH Prince of Wales Gold Medal; the Allianz Arts & Business Sculptural Awards Commission; the Empreinte Atelier de Gravure, Luxembourg 2019 Residency Award, as well as several ACNI and RUA awards.

The imagery in Karen's work reflects her interest in habitat, culture and literature. She enlists line and colour as a language to explore the perimeters of printmaking, with symbolism as an allegory, deconstructing situations, fairy tales, nursery rhymes or poetry that are part of our childhood and adult culture. Using mapping, lines, text and texture to give the viewer additional information or to view or provoke the underlying subject or concept, the stories told are either autobiographical or historical or a layering of both.

Karen's works are held in a number of prestigious collections throughout the world including: China, Greece, India, Ireland, London, Netherlands, New Mexico, and New York. She is one of only two Northern Irish artists elected members of the prestigious Prism Print International organisation, an international organisation of master print artists whose mission is to promote the art of fine art printmaking worldwide.

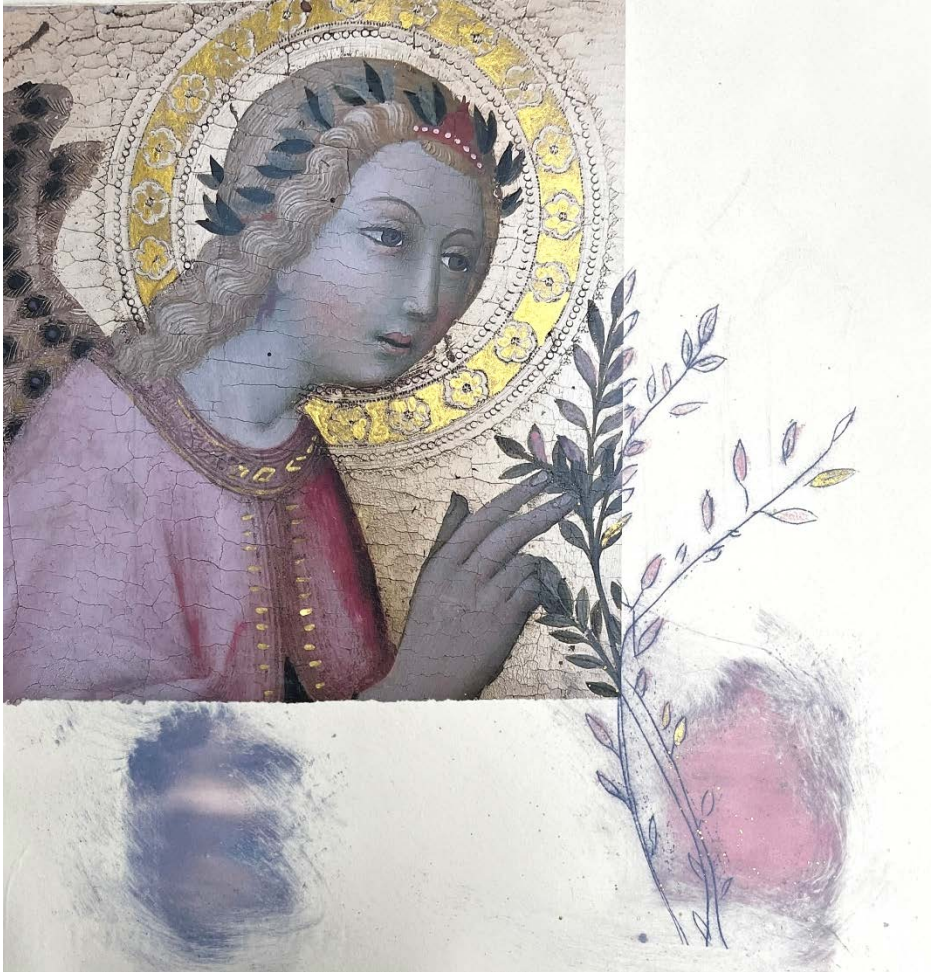

## DÉIRDRE KELLY

Although raised in Dublin, Déirdre was born in London in 1962, and obtained a Master of Arts in Printmaking from Wimbledon School of Art in 1984 and on graduating was elected a member of the Royal Society of Painter Printmakers.



Her work plays with the language of calligraphy to create a personalized landscape from which emerge impossible landscapes, routes and directions. Standing before her 'altered' maps, the viewer is both found and displaced in relation to pictorial worlds. Déirdre's map collages remind us of the human need and desire for physical maps, now more than ever.

Déirdre's work can be found in many collections including: the MOMA Library, New York; Tate Gallery Library, London; Reuters Ltd; Ashmoleum Museum, Oxford; Luciano Benetton Collection, Italy; Museu da Gravura, Curitiba, Brazil; National Gallery of Canada Library, Canada; Ballinglen Arts Foundation; NIVAL, Dublin, Ireland; and Sedgewick Group International.

Awards include: British Council Exchange residency at Museu da Gravura Brazil; Whatman Paper Prize, Atlantis Paper Purchase Prize, Sericol Purchase Prize, and in 2021 she became a Companion of John Ruskin's Guild of St George.

Déirdre currently lives in Venice, Italy, where she is Curator of the Scuola Internazionale di Grafica.

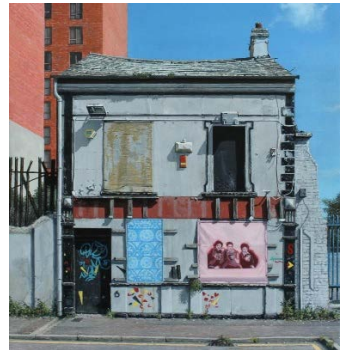
