

HOW TO FELT A SHED ROOF





Felting the roof of your shed is the last stage of construction. Attaching the roofing felt correctly is very important as the felt will help protect your shed from wind, rain and snow. We supply rolls of roofing felt with all our buildings and the amount you receive depends on the size of your building.

What you will need to install:

- Tape Measure
- Step Ladder
- Stanley Knife
- Hammer
- Felt Tacks

Steps To Follow:

- 1. Firstly, measure the total area of your shed roof. Write these down and refer back when checking the amount of felt you have.
- 2. Measure the felt and mark out how much you'll need, when marking out and cutting the felt make sure to cut the felt a little longer than what you need. If you haven't received enough roofing felt please contact our Customer Service Team, they will ensure replacement felt is sent out to you.
- 3. Then check the roof of your shed, look for any nails or debris. Nails and debris could damage the roofing felt when you are trying to attach it.
- 4. Always make sure the roof boards are completely dry before laying the felt. Roofing felt should NOT be applied on to a wet or damp roof.
- 5. Start from the bottom end of the roof, hold it tight against the roof and roll the felt towards the front of the shed. Remember to leave an overhang of felt on all three sides, side, back and front. The felt should overhang by at least 3/4 of an inch.
