Your leather products will soften over time. Colors will get richer and deeper over time, when your leather is cared for properly. Expect more beauty out of your product over time. Let it bear the scuffs, scars, and character that tell the story of all of the adventures you've been through together! Following these guidelines will result in your leash, collar, bag, or other custom product wearing, conforming, and molding to YOU through the years!

DOs:

- Regularly clean with a soft brush or dry cloth
 - Remove soils with a DAMP cloth
 - Bring a shine or polish with a dry cloth
 - Blot excessive water as soon as possible
 - Dry leather naturally
- Condition your investment with a high-quality leather conditioner every 3-6 months
- Feel free to use a leather sealer for your leather goods that will be exposed to the elements.

DON'Ts:

- Use a heat source to dry your leather
 - Use harsh cleaners
- Store your leather in an airtight container
- Leave your leather product in direct sunlight
