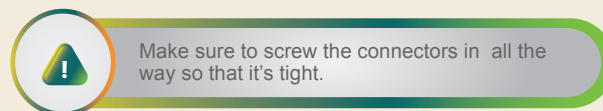
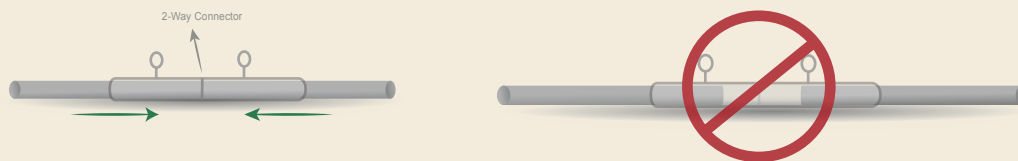
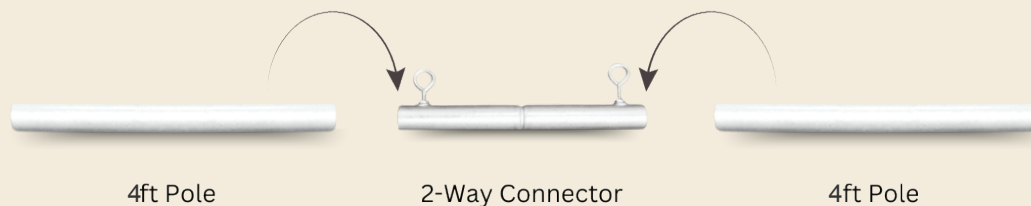
Step 1



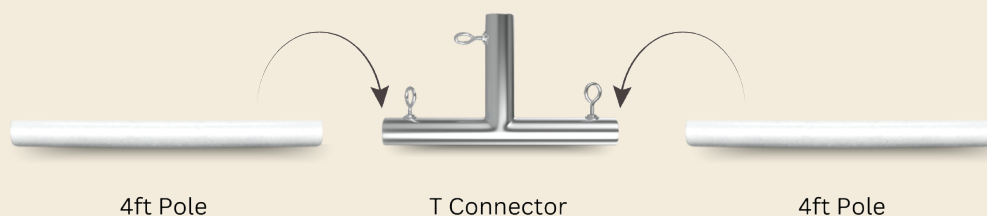
Attach a 5-foot pole to one side of the two-way connector, then attach the second 5-foot pole to the other side. This will create a 10-foot pole. Repeat this process until you have made seven 10-foot poles for the Sukkah frame.

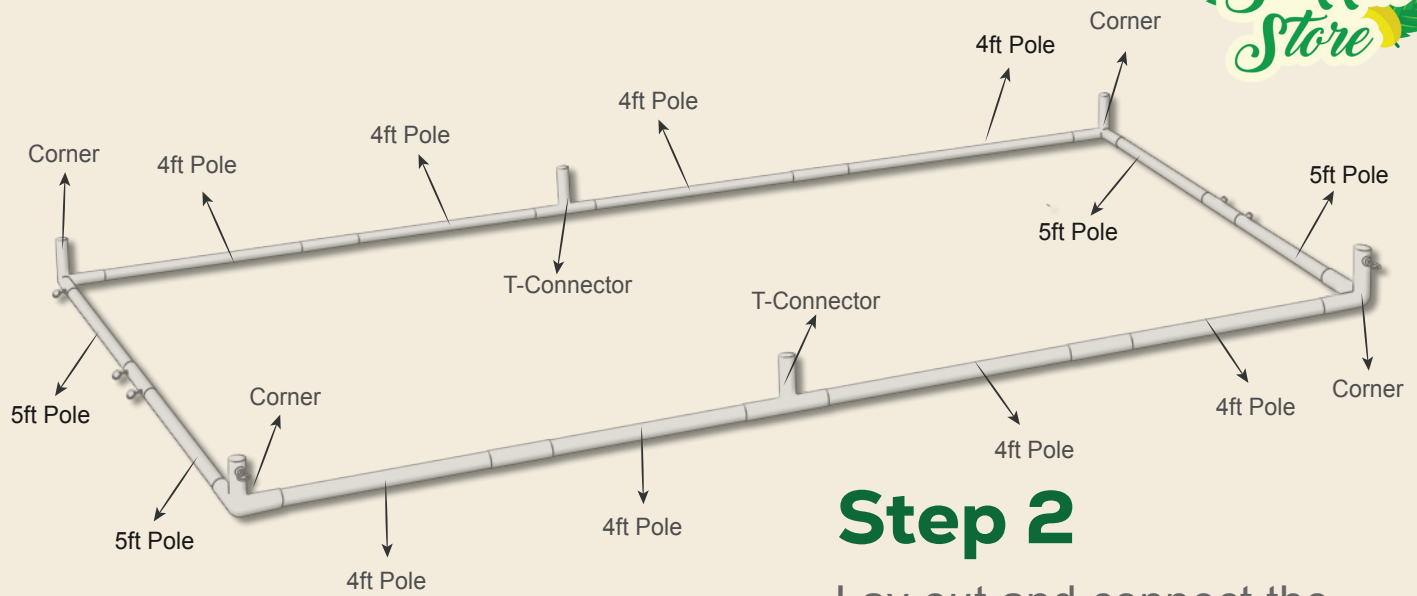


Attach a 4-foot pole to one side of the two-way connector, then attach the second 4-foot pole to the other side. This will create an 8-foot pole. Repeat this process until you have made ten 8-foot poles for the Sukkah frame.



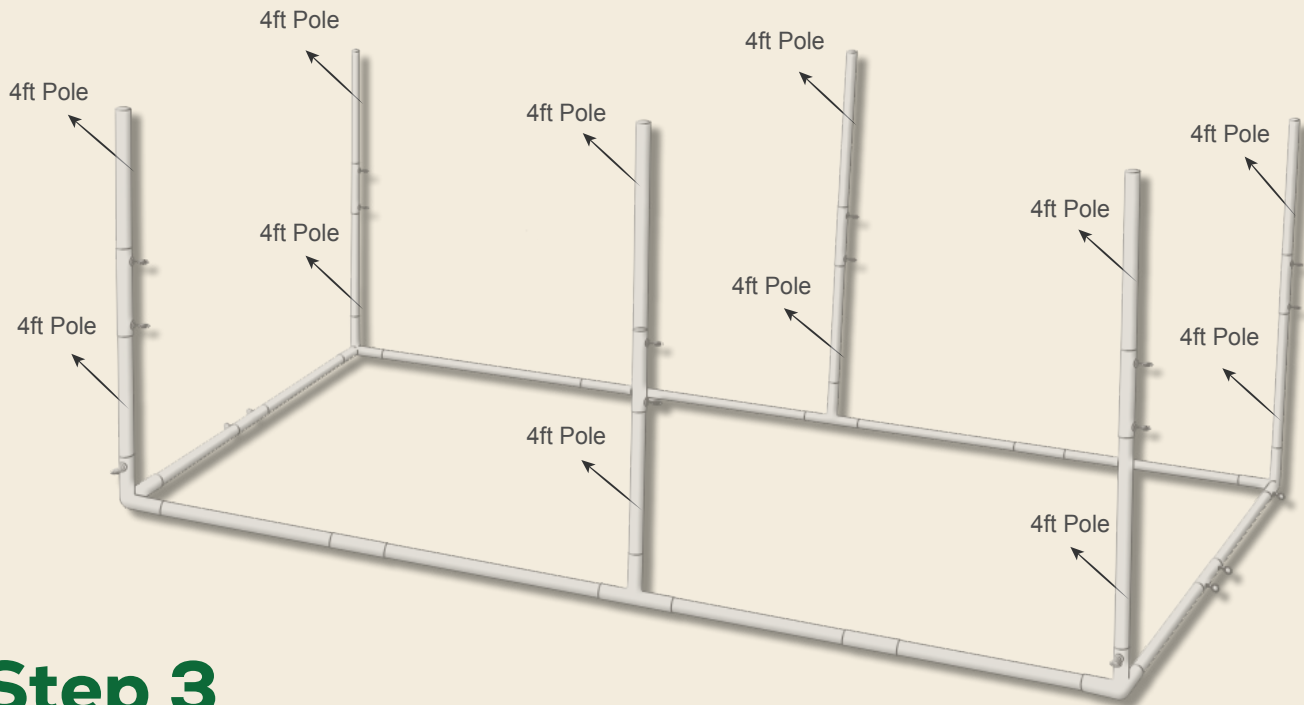
Attach a 4-foot pole to one side of the T-connector, then attach a second 4-foot pole to the other side. This will create a 8-foot pole with T-connector in the middle. Repeat this process until you have made four 8-foot poles for the Sukkah frame.





Step 2

Lay out and connect the base of the Sukkah

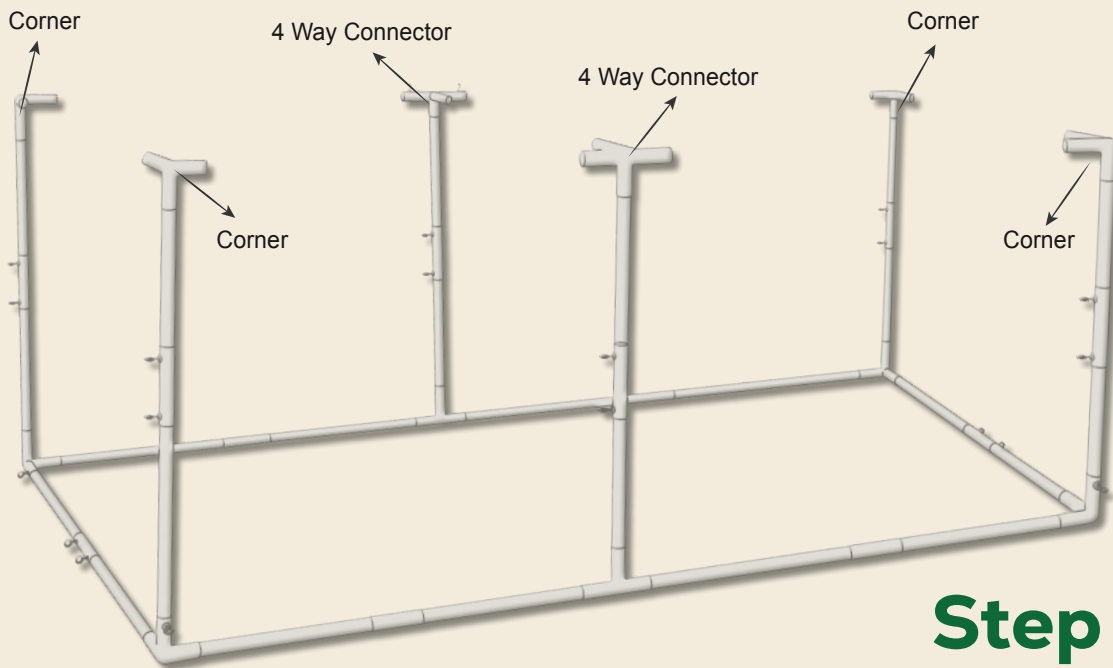


Step 3

Connect the vertical poles

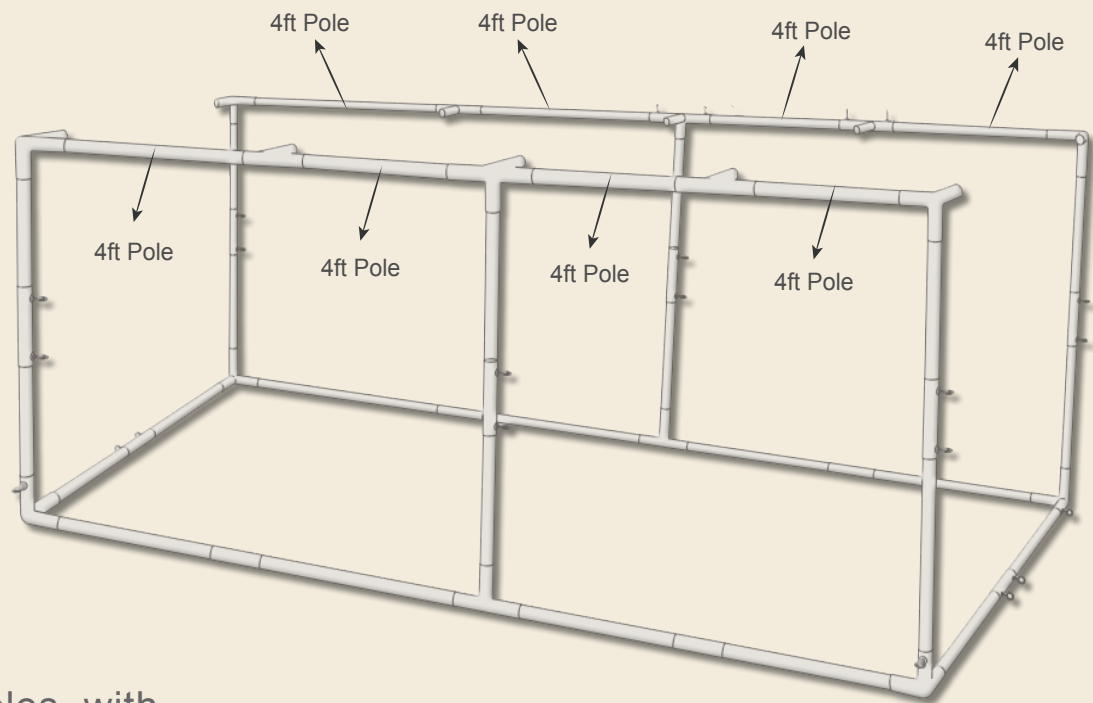


Be careful to make sure the poles are stabilized so they don't fall. If you are building the Sukkah by yourself, we advise to build one section at a time for the top of the frame



Step 4

Connect the 4 corners and 4-ways to the top of the poles.



Step 5

Add in the 4ft poles, with T-connectors, for the roof.

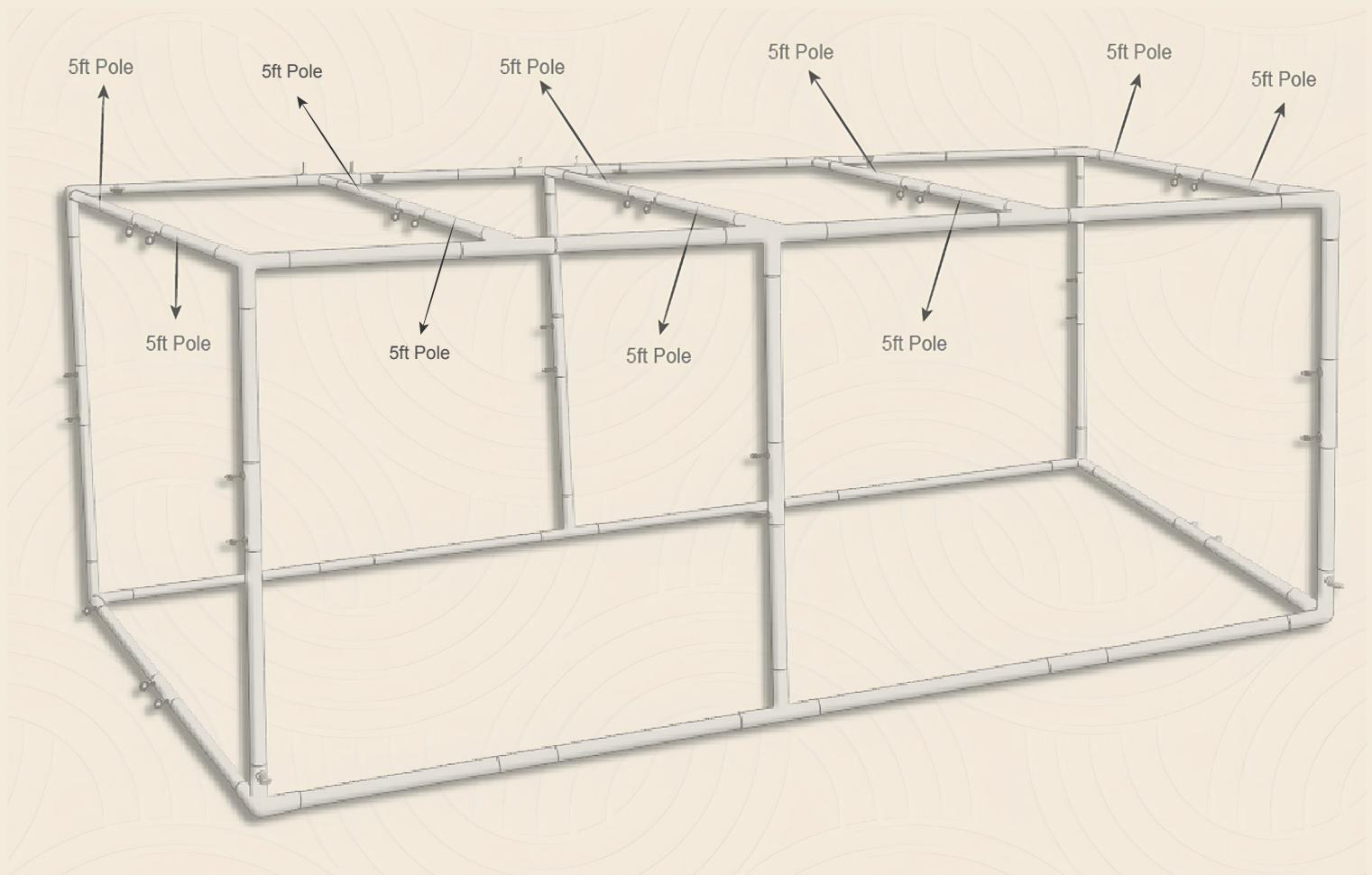

Step 6

Add in the rest of the poles for the roof



Be careful to make sure the poles are stabilized so they don't fall. If you are building the Sukkah by yourself, we advise to build one section at a time for the top of the frame



Put up the walls by wrapping the velcro around the corners first, then completing the rest.

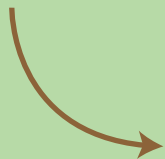
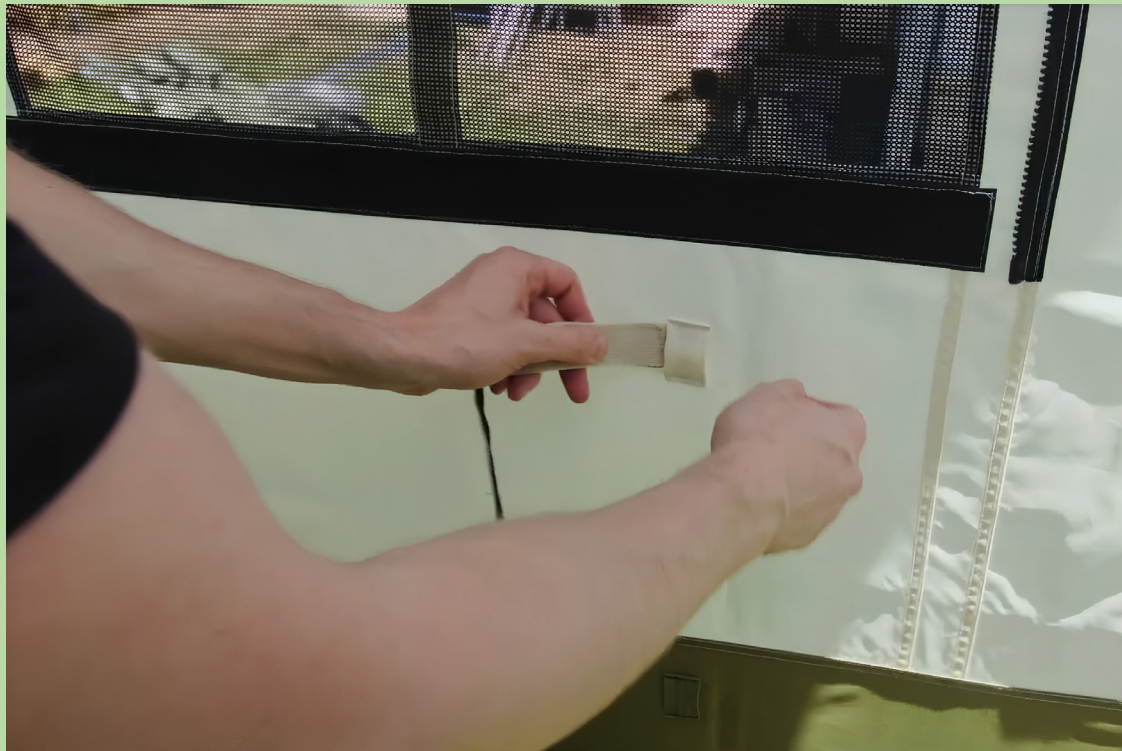


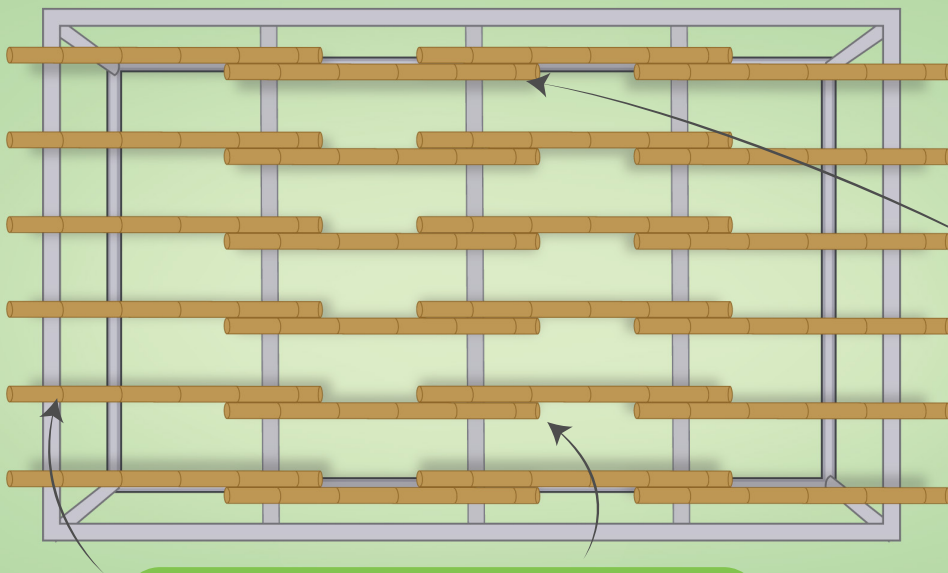
Start by zipping the walls together, leaving the door panel for last. For the door panel, use the inside (tighter) zipper if possible.



Center the walls on the frame, then retighten all the velcros to smoothen the walls.

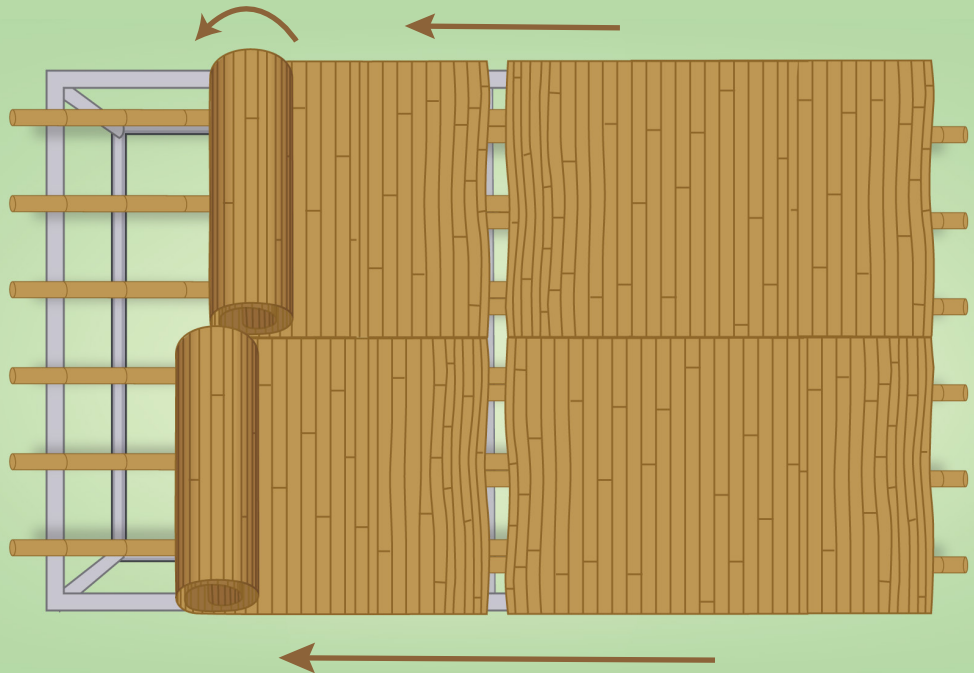
Run the Lavud straps starting next to the door, threading them through the loops on the walls and around the Sukkah. Ensure the strap is tightly secured to the frame once complete.





Ensure the poles extend a few inches beyond the Sukkah frame to prevent slipping

Place the bamboo poles on top of the frame, positioning them tightly against each other to create one long bamboo pole to support the schach, as shown in the image.



Roll the bamboo mat in the same direction as the bamboo poles. This will ensure the mat sits properly on the bamboo without drooping.
