
## Step 1



Attach a 3-foot pole to one side of the two-way connector, then attach the second 3-foot pole to the other side. This will create a 6-foot pole. Repeat this process until you have made five 6-foot poles for the Sukkah frame.




Attach a 4-foot pole to one side of the two-way connector, then attach the second 4-foot pole to the other side. This will create a 8-foot pole. Repeat this process until you have made five 8-foot poles for the Sukkah frame.





Attach a 4-foot pole to one side of the T-connector, then attach a second 4-foot pole to the other side. This will create a 8-foot pole with T-connector in the middle. Repeat this process until you have made two 8-foot poles for the Sukkah frame.













## Step 5


Add in the 4ft poles, with T-connectors, for the roof.





## Step 6


## Add in the rest of the poles for the roof





Be careful to make sure the poles are stablilized so they don't fall. If you are building the Sukkah by yourself, we advise to build one section at a time for the top of the frame







Roll the bamboo mat in the same direction as the bamboo poles. This will ensure the mat sits properly on the bamboo without drooping.
