ANDY'S STORY AND THE ORIGIN OF THE ROSARY AND SCAPULAR INITIATIVE



The Rosary and Scapular initiative was founded by Andy Maggio in 2019, when he began giving rosaries and scapulars to members of his own parish.

A short time later, he contacted the chaplain at the Veteran's Hospital where his brother-in-law

was terminally ill, requesting that a scapular be placed around his neck. The chaplain had no scapulars or rosary beads to provide. Andy told him that he would send him a shipment of both.

And so, the mission began. It expanded initially to Veterans' Hospitals in the area. Since that time, the ministry has grown significantly.

As of today, hundreds of thousands of prayer kits have been sent to organizations across the U.S and to countries around the globe.

The kits have been mailed to Veterans' Hospitals, Boys Town, EWTN, St. Jude Children's Hospital, Covenant House, Catholic schools and churches, prisons, and hospice organizations. Kits have been sent to Ukraine, Cuba, England, the Virgin Islands, India, Africa and Medjugorje in Bosnia.





Each prayer kit contains:

- A Brown Scapular
- A pair of Rosary beads
- Literature containing the history of the Brown Scapular and the miracles associated with it
- Instruction on How to Say the Rosary and
- The Divine Mercy Chaplet

Many volunteers work with us to sort rosaries and scapulars, print literature, assemble kits, pack and transport boxes for shipping, and handle correspondence.

To date the cost of materials and operations has been funded solely by Andy and a small number of individual contributors.

We are in need of prayers and donations to support this initiative. Contributions will be used to cover the cost of rosaries and scapulars, brochures, printing supplies, packing materials and shipping.
