## Microfiber Laundering Tips

1. NEVER use fabric softener
2. ALWAYS use an approved Microfiber washing detergent only. Use to mfg specifications. Hang to dry or use right
3. NEVER heat dry your microfiber. This will cause the fiber fingers used to grab the dirt/germs to shrivel up and no longer be effective in cleaning.
4. NEVER mix any other fabric when washing your microfiber. Fabric fibers will clog the microfiber fingers, leaving your microfiber ineffective.
