Our box matches are handmade in Oxfordshire, England. The box designs are printed on beautiful textured board using

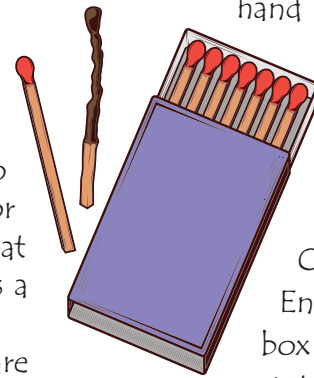
a traditional letterpress. The packaging is compostable and eco-friendly, and the sticks are sourced from certified woodlands.

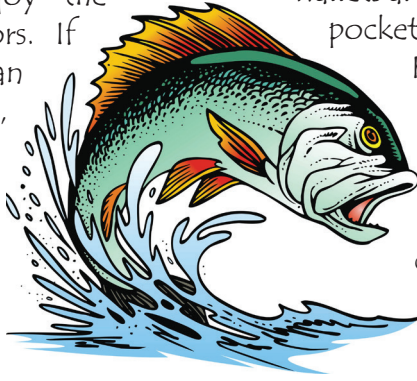
Games and Grilling

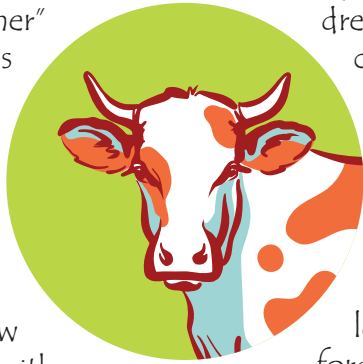
