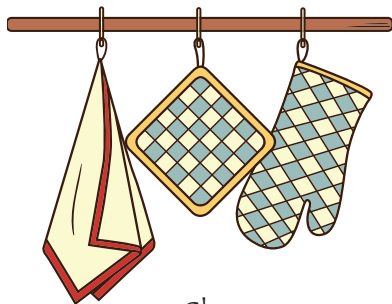

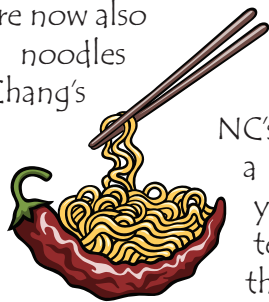

Tasty All Year Long

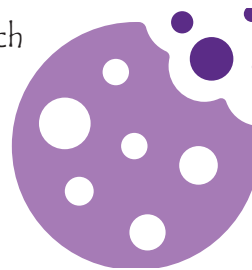
Sweater Box Confections, based in NC's Outer Banks might have a wintry name, but once you've tried these bite sized tea cookies, you'll want them year round.
