They build their collections around youthful staples, from tailored power suits and coordinated co-ords to soft dresses, resort wear, and swim pieces using Naia™ sustainable celluloseacetate fabric, which offers sculptural drape with a reduced environmental footprint. The brand blends crisp tailoring and romantic details, from structured blazers and highwaist trousers to flowing ombré satin sets and delicate lace dresses, creating an am-to-pm wardrobe that's as ethical as it is elegant . •
