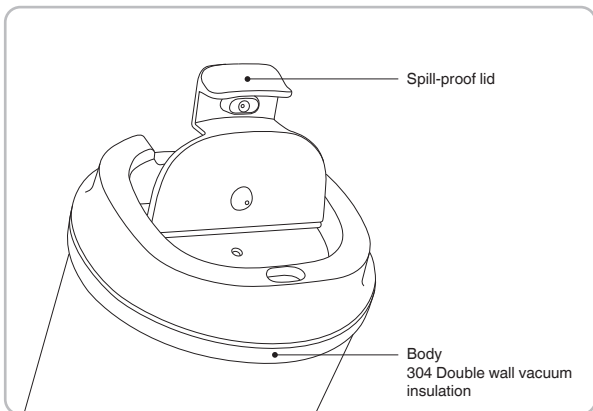


Cuckoo Tumbler User Manual

CVB-E48SW

Thank you for purchasing a CUCKOO product. To ensure proper product handling, please read this user manual in its entirety prior to using.



※ To prevent a burn, be sure to check the content's temperature prior to use.

How to Clean

Part	How to Clean	Caution
Lid, cup opening	Wash with a suitable amount of soap and lukewarm water. Wipe to dry with a soft cloth.	Since temperature resistance vary depending on material, do not wash at a high temperature.
Sealing	Although high-temperature sterilization is possible, be careful as the sealing may deform and/or stick to bottom of the pot.	Sterilize for 3 to 5 minutes in boiling water.
Inside the tumbler	Overtime, rust or water stains may develop inside the tumbler due to water quality, foreign substances, etc. If this occurs, fill the tumbler with about 90% hot water and 10% vinegar. Let it soak for 30 minutes to an hour before wiping thoroughly.	To avoid damage, do not scratch the tumbler's interior with any hard objects.
Outside the tumbler	Wash the exterior with lukewarm water and a suitable amount of soap. After cleaning, rinse off with water, then remove any moisture with a dry cloth.	You can sterilize the tumbler by placing it into boiling water or disinfectant. However, do not sterilize it with high-temperature steam or water for an extended period of time. Doing so may deform some of the parts and/or damage to the vacuum structure.

Warning & Caution

Please review the following prior to use:

1. Overfilling or tilting the tumbler with hot liquids may cause it to leak, which may lead to a burn.
2. If the tumbler contains a hot beverage, keep it out of children's reach.
3. Do not place it next to anything flammable. This may cause a deformation and/or discoloration.
4. Keep the tumbler upright when filling. To prevent spilling, ensure the lid is properly secured before sipping.
5. Do not microwave a tumbler as it may cause dangerous sparks. This can also potentially deform and/or discolor the tumbler.
6. Do not store in a freezer or boil it in hot water. This may deform the tumbler and/or deteriorate its performance.
7. Do not drop, throw, or apply any excessive pressure/shock to the product.
8. Please do not exceed liquid past max fill line.
