



## 20" Heated Bird Bath Bowl

### Quality Features:

- Works to -20 degrees F (-29 degrees C)
- Thermostatically controlled to conserve energy
- Turns on at 45 degrees F - Turns off at 60 degrees F
- Hidden heating element with 2' power cord
- 120 Volt/125.6 Watts/60 Hz.

### Directions:

Before plugging in your bath and adding water, place the bath outside (in the stand or deck mount holder) for a couple hours to adjust to the outside temperature. This will ensure that the thermostat will turn the heater on when needed. Once this has been done and the bird bath is located where you wish to watch the birds, pour water in the bath to determine if it is level. If not, move it around until it is level.

Attach the 2' cord to an extension cord that is rated for outdoor use. Wrap several layers of electrical tape around the connection between the bird bath and your extension cord. Plug the extension cord into a properly grounded outdoor electrical outlet. To use the bath in the seasons other than winter, the cord can be disconnected from the extension cord and wrapped under the bowl.

For the health of your backyard birds, keep the bath clean. The finish on the bath makes it easy to keep clean, just wipe with a wet cloth or soft brush. Rinse well before refilling. Never submerge the entire bowl in water.
