NOT ANOTHER WORD GAME™





THE AIM OF THE GAME > PLAY ALL THE CARDS IN YOUR HAND FIRST.

SET UP > PICK A DEAL FR

- THE DEALER CREATES A 3, 4, OR 5
 LETTER WORD FROM ANY CARDS IN
 THE DECK AND PLACES THAT WORD
 IN THE MIDDLE OF THE TABLE.
 (MAKE UNCOMMON WORDS
 TO MAKE IT HARDER!)
- THE DEALER THEN SHUFFLES
 THE REMAINING CARDS AND DEALS
 CARDS TO EACH PLAYER.
- THE DEALER PLACES THE REMAINING CARDS FACE DOWN IN A DRAW PILE.
- STARTING WITH THE PLAYER ON THE LEFT OF THE DEALER, AND PROCEEDING CLOCKWISE, EACH PLAYER PERFORMS ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1 PLACE A LETTER FROM YOUR
 HAND ON TOP OF ONE OF THE
 LETTERS TO MAKE A NEW WORD
 + OPTIONAL REARRANGE
- 2 PLACE A LETTER FROM YOUR
 HAND IN A NEW SPOT TO CREATE
 A LONGER WORD (MAX. 5 SPOTS)
 + OPTIONAL REARRANGE
- TO MAKE A SHORTER WORD (MIN. 3 SPOTS) + OPTIONAL REARRANGE (YOU DO NOT GET RID OF A CARD FROM YOUR HAND, BUT COULD MAKE A MORE DIFFICULT WORD FOR YOUR OPPONENT OR EASIER WORD FOR A FUTURE TURN!)
- 4 EXCHANGE 1 OR MORE CARDS IN YOUR HAND BY PUTTING THEM IN A DISCARD PILE AND REPLACING THEM FROM THE DRAW PILE

OPTIONAL REARRANGE > YOU CAN REARRANGE THE ORDER OF ANY OR ALL OF THE LETTER STACKS WHILE CREATING YOUR NEW WORD

LAST CARD DRAWN > IF A PLAYER DRAWS THE LAST CARD FROM THE DRAW PILE AND COMPLETES THEIR TURN, EACH PLAYER (INCLUDING THAT PLAYER) GETS ONE MORE TURN. THEN THE GAME ENDS.

THE WINNER IS > THE FIRST PLAYER
TO GET RID OF ALL THEIR CARDS, OR
HAS THE FEWEST CARDS IN HAND
AFTER THE 'LAST CARD DRAWN' RULE.

(OR)

IF "NOT ANOTHER WORD" CAN BE MADE, THE PLAYER WHO PLAYED THE LAST WORD WINS


EXAMPLES SHOWING THE THREE CREATION **OPTIONS**

OPTIONAL: YOU CAN REARRANGE THE ORDER OF ANY OR ALL OF THE LETTER STACKS WHILE CREATING YOUR NEW WORD

1 PLACING A LETTER ON TOP OF A LETTER ALREADY PLAYED




PLACE 'P' ON TOP OF 'L' TO GO FROM LAWN TO PAWN 2 PLACING A LETTER IN A NEW SPOT TO CREATE A LONGER WORD (MAX. 5 LETTERS)



ADD 'R' TO **PAWN** TO CREATE **PRAWN**

3 COMBINE TWO LETTERS (STACKS) TO MAKE A SHORTER WORD (MIN. 3 LETTERS)



COMBINE 'W' AND 'N' STACKS AND REARRANGE TO CREATE WARP

WHAT IS A WORD? > WORDS MUST BE FOUND IN A DICTIONARY OF YOUR CHOICE, AND CANNOT BE PROPER NAMES / PLACES OR ABBREVIATIONS.
