What a year for Homes for Veterans! With your support, we expanded our board to seven dedicated members, hosted our Inaugural Gala, and built meaningful partnerships with dozens of new volunteers who have joined our mission. **Our Gala raised \$27,000**, a testament to the generosity and dedication of those who believe in this cause. As we carry forward the mission my father started in 2011, we remain committed to addressing the challenges veterans face—both the new obstacles that arise and the struggles that have persisted for years.

This year, we focused heavily on raising awareness about the lack of resources and funding gaps that leave too many veterans—especially our aging heroes from the Vietnam era—without the support they need and deserve. These brave men and women should never feel forgotten, and at Homes for Veterans, we make sure they are seen, heard, and supported in every way possible.

Our impact this year has been tremendous. **We proudly completed 15 barrier-free modification projects**, helping veterans regain their independence and dignity within their own homes. Even more exciting, **Homes for Veterans has now completed projects in 19 states—a milestone that reflects how far our mission has spread** and how many lives we are touching across the country. We also **donated thousands of essential items to veterans living at the Borden Avenue Homeless Shelter** and other veteran facilities—ensuring that even those in the most difficult circumstances know they are not alone.

This work would not be possible without our incredible partners: **Blackstone, Adopt A Soldier Platoon, Courage and Sacrifice, and Northwestern Mutual**. Their support, combined with yours, has allowed us to transform lives, provide safety and accessibility, and restore hope to the heroes who have served our country.

But the heart of this mission is you—our donors, our supporters, our community. Your generosity fuels every home we modify, every veteran we assist, and every act of kindness we extend. Because of you, I can carry on my father’s mission, ensuring his legacy continues to change lives.

Every single day, we change lives, save lives, and touch lives. And none of it would be possible without you. I am incredibly grateful for this purpose, for this team, and for what lies ahead. We have so much more to do—and together, we will do it.
