Pascal Luyton and Raphaël Fleury are two cousins with a passion for wine and the Northern Rhône. Taking over the family plots was therefore an obvious choice and that is how the Luyton-Fleury estate was born. Located near the town of Mauves, this domain offers us lovely Saint-Joseph, Crozes-Hermitage, and Saint-Péray wines.

TASTING NOTES

Plenty of ripe red and black fruits, peppery herbs, spice, and flowery, meaty notes emerge from this Crozes-Hermitage Terre du Sud, a medium-bodied, beautifully balanced, elegant Crozes that has nicely integrated acidity and, again, this floral, pretty, complex style.

WINEMAKING

Complete de-stemming after reception of the harvest, fermentation in stainless steel tanks, followed by a three week maceration
