THE STORY

AVENUE TERROIR

The estate belongs to the Barrier family since 1850 when the phylloxera destroyed their entire vineyard. Robert Barriere, the grandfather of the present owner, is the first president of the Sauveterre winery. Then comes the frost of 1956 where all the vines were replanted again. Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon are worked in a reasoned way, without chemical fertilizers in order to perpetuate the tradition of the ancestors, giving a fine wine, fruity and colorful.

TASTING NOTES

This wine is of a deep garnet color with a nose of ripe red fruit discreet, blackcurrant and toast. Round palate and full-bodied, with a hint of freshness, gives pride to the fruit.

WINEMAKING

Grapes are vinified separately up to blending.

Cold maceration before starting alcoholic fermentation.

Once the malolactic fermentation is over the grapes are blended. Blending can be different from one vintage to the other depending on the maturity of the grapes

FOOD PAIRING

This wine will go well with chicken salad, pulled-pork, shepherd's pie, vegetables cooked in sauce, hamburgers & aged cheese.
