

# LA TOURBEILLE'S STORY

La Tourbeille has been a Bordeaux wine-producing property for centuries, and home to our French American family for five generations. The 25-acre vineyard is perched on a sunny hilltop above the Dordogne River on the Côte de La Tourbeille. La Tourbeille is a small-scale family producer and creates its wines in its own winery at the vineyard. Location: 20 kilometers east of St Emilion, in the appellation region Entre Deux Mers.

### **TASTING NOTES**

L'Esprit de Jeanne offers light floral notes of summer berries and cherry blossoms. Elegant perfumed, dry and refreshing.

#### WINEMAKING

The picking process starts in the cool temperatures before dawn to prevent oxidation and immediately started pressing. Pneumatic press, working along and gentle cycle helped ensure the pale pink color and delicate floral aromas. At the end of the fermentation period, the winery undertook a manual brassage of the lies to bring out a subtle grass on the palate. This Rosé was matured in a custom-made stainless steel tank and bottled on 29 January 2021.

#### **FOOD PAIRING**

This Elegant fruity rosé will pair well with seafood such as lobster, seared salmon, tuna, or duck; and delicately cooked rare lamb.

Good too with white-rinded cheeses such as Camembert and Brie.

45 % Merlot 40% Cabernet Franc 15% Cabernet-Sauvignon
