


FIND YOUR RING SIZE USING OUR SIZER

1. On your print dialog box, make sure the scalling is set to '100%'. Print this page and use a ruler to confirm the accuracy of the print, comparing with the sample below.




- 2. Cut out the ring sizer. Cut slit on the dotted line near "start here".
- 3. Wrap the sizer around your finger to determine your size, by inserting the pointed end through the slit. The number where it overlaps is your size.

RING MEASURING TIPS

- The best time to measure your fingers is at the end of the day, as fingers tend to swell during the day.
- Make sure that your hands aren't too cold. When we're cold, our fingers shrink in size.
- If you fall somewhere between two sizes, always choose a size up.

FIND YOUR RING SIZE USING A RING YOU OWN

Using an existing ring that already fits you well, you can use a ruler to measure the inside diameter of the ring. Simply measure straight across the inside of the ring from edge to edge, or place it on the printed circle which best fits the ring's inner diameter.



Ring Size	Circumference	Diameter (inner)
3	44.5mm	13.5mm / 0.53"
4	47mm	14.2mm / 0.55"
5	49.5mm	15.7mm / 0.62"
6	52mm	16.5mm / 0.65"
7	54.5mm	17.3mm / 0.68"
8	57mm	18.2mm / 0.72"
9	59.5mm	18.9mm / 0.75"
10	62.1mm	19.8mm / 0.78"
11	64.6mm	20.2mm / 0.8"
